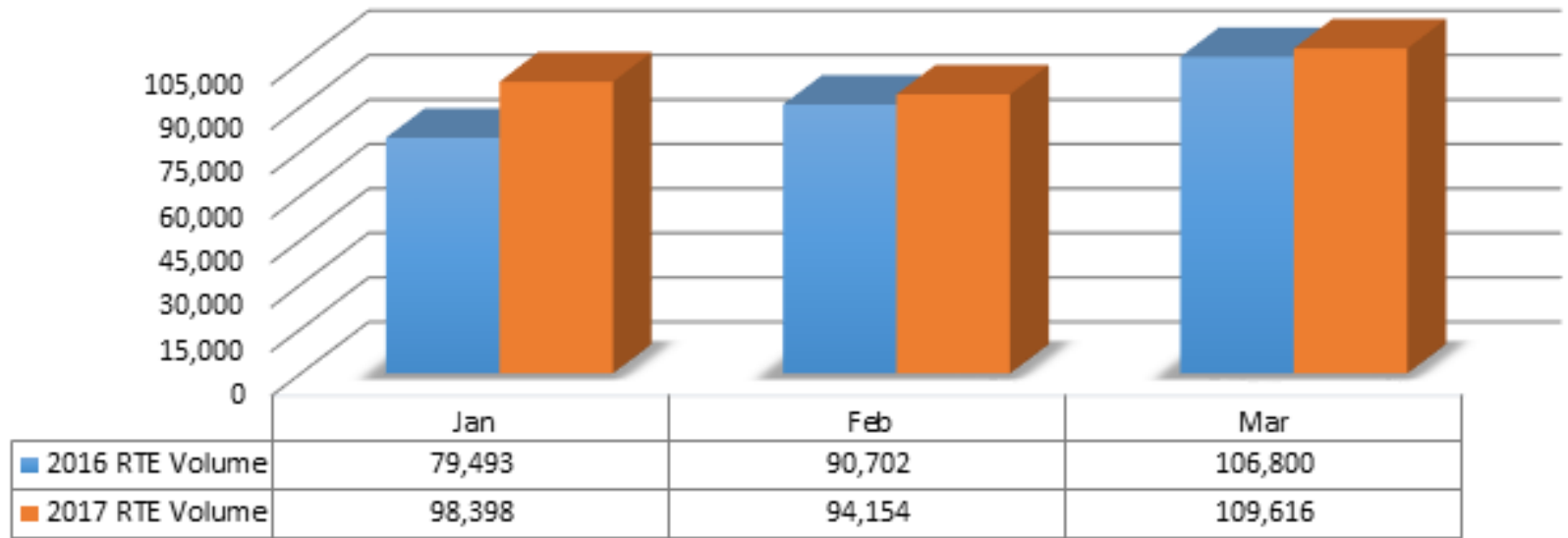

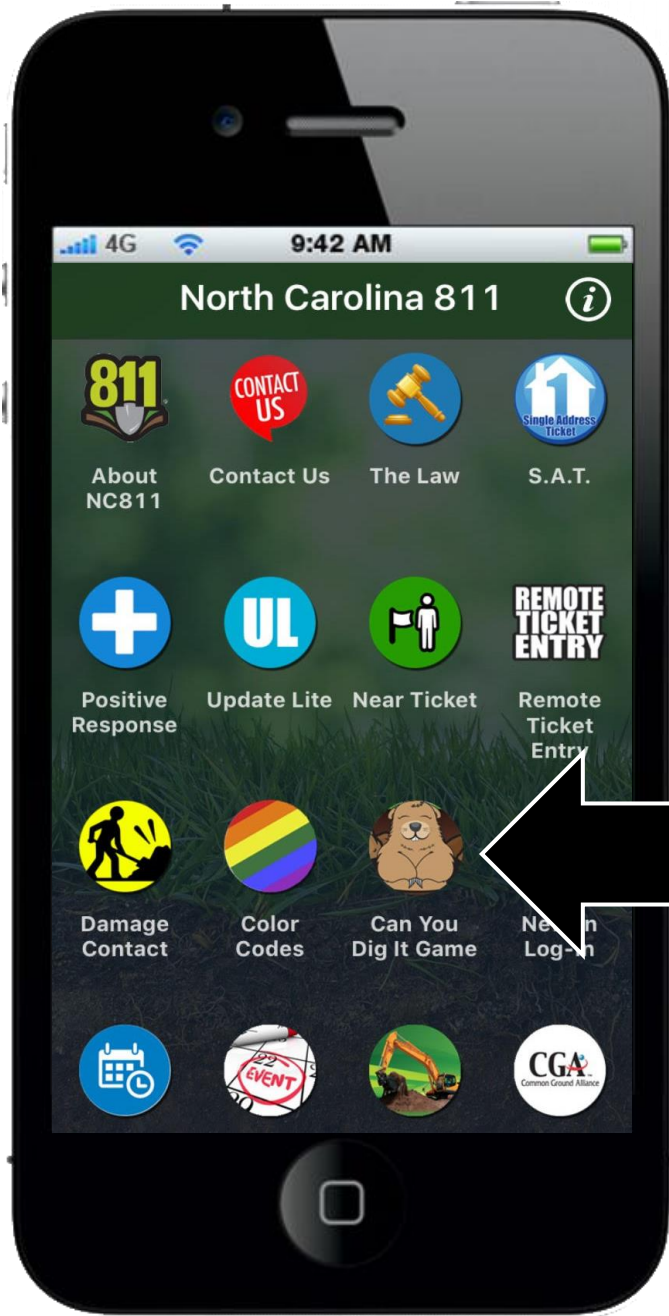


New Members

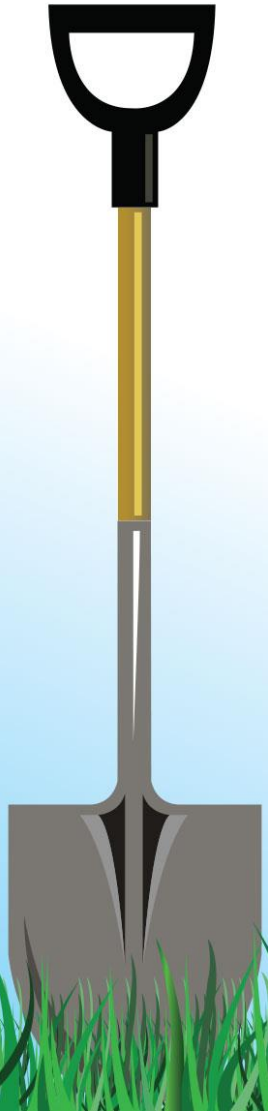

Piedmont Natural Gas-Doing retirements and anodes on Sikes, Maple next week or two. Do work orders, then locate, then remove map, then re-scan as retired. Anything 5 years or more. Getting rid of steel pipe and replacing with plastic. Possible job upcoming on Stanback Ferry. Talk is to take poultry waste, compress it, convert into methane and then sell it.

Pee Dee Electric-Doing a number of pole changes in Anson Co. Upper & Lower White Store Road, Prison Camp Road, Camden Church Road. Locates on some. Union Co-Philidelphia Church Road, Landsford Road, & Smithfield Road. Approximately 100. Stanly Co-90 day project. Lines from field to road. Old Ruby Road, Gatewood Road. DOT jobs w/Pee Dee-no issues.

Town of Wadesboro-New fire department is being built on Morgan Street. Grading work and retaining wall being done. KFC is going to build a new restaurant. The old Sun Trust Bank building is to be torn down. New connection going in to emergency interconnection. Building, valves, and meter equipment. DOT will be tearing out the intersection at Stanback Ferry Road. To be reworked. Work is to be done at night. Supposed to be done by Memorial Day. Still unknown about the new Agriculture Center project. It was supposed to be a 2018 project.
