





PeeDee Electric-

Work in Union County-High Ridge Road, White Street, Gilboa Road. Maintenance and upgrades continuing. Work in Stanly County-Hardy Road, Plank Road. Construction work plan continuing. Will be retiring substation. Anson County 109S doing pole replacements to the state line. The bio plant is still in the works.

Town of Wadesboro-
