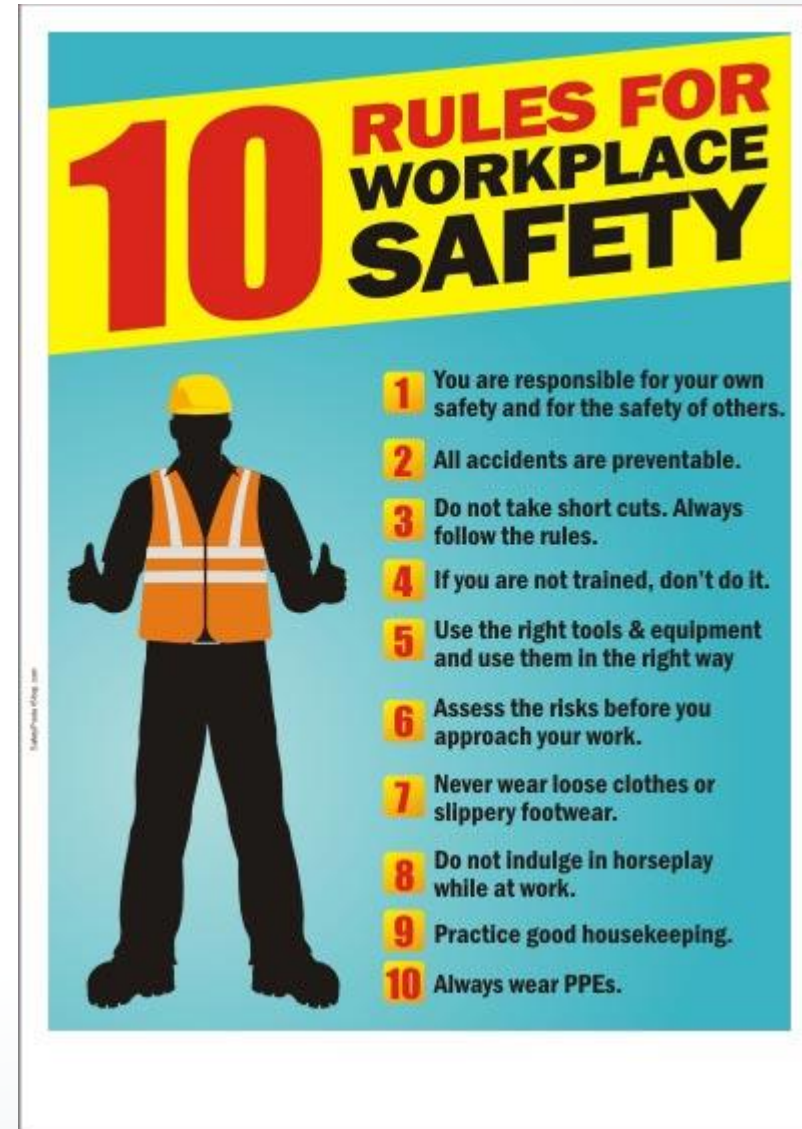

In process of building an emergency water interconnect with Anson County. From Anson Co to Town of Wadesboro. Will be above ground. \$200k project.

Grassed median-109/Old 74 to Allen Pond Road to Wadesboro. 2.9 miles. \$11,000,000 project (has been approved).

No completion date on AgriCivic center project known. (2018?)

KFC project in process. Grading work in process.

Bojangles has purchased land that previously housed the Lady Bug Restaurant. Plans are to build new Bojangles beside of current location.

Town of Wadesboro will now be receiving their locates via text. Currently working with NC811. Testing this week to make sure everything is operational.
