Destroyed Marks & 3 Hour Tickets

When to properly use each

A series of several parallel white lines of varying lengths and thicknesses, slanted diagonally from the bottom-left towards the top-right, located on the right side of the slide.

DESTROYED MARKS

If locate marks have been destroyed, the excavator must contact NC811 to issue a Destroyed Marks ticket requesting a remark of the area from the original ticket.

A Destroyed Marks ticket does not extend the life of ticket; it will expire the same day as the original locate request. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in case of destroyed marks.

3 HOUR TICKET

If an operator fails to respond to the positive response system, the excavator may proceed if there are no visible indications of a facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, such as a pole, marker, pedestal, meter, or valve. However, if the excavator is aware of or observes indications of an unmarked facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, the excavator shall not begin excavation or demolition until an additional call is made to the Notification Center detailing the facility and an arrangement is made for the facility to be marked by the operator within three hours from the time the additional call is received by the Notification Center. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in the case of destroyed marks.

Anson County UCC Meeting
February 2018

Meeting opened by Chair, David Burr at 9:10 am.

PeeDee Electric- Stanly County is rebuilding a line bringing poles 31' from the center of the road. Aquadale spotted the poles.

Doing pole replacements on 109s (in and out of town).

Working with NCDOT on several bridge jobs in Richmond and Anson Counties. Thomas Road and Ruby Road close to completion. Hwy 73 & #1 bridge jobs going on. Routine jobs are ongoing. 109 S/Tulip Road-lots of orange marks on the ground. Do not know what is going on out that way.

Discussion about joint use overhead and how to handle for pole replacement.

NCDOT-As discussed lot of bridgework going on. Little Huntley Road-more pipe replacement by June 30 then to Taylor Road and Gulledege Road. Many contracts letting. White Store Road. 109 to the Mini Mart is having a median and turnout installed as well as grassed in median. It is being surveyed now.

Cablehound-No problems as long as they are doing ok. Has some larger projects coming up. Windstream/AT&T Fiber, and Google Fiber work. AT&T Fiber work on 52.

Windstream-Lunar projects. Builds 3500' or less. Placing near where they have current systems. These give more bandwidth to customers. Do not know of any lunars in Anson or Union Counties. Forest Hills Road-fiber to new toll road. Small projects-possible completion date October/November but will still have construction ongoing.

MCNC-New handholds.
