


County Ticket Distribution



Update your NC 811 app.



If the diameter or width of the facility is greater than four inches, the dimension of the facility shall be indicated at least every 50 feet in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition. An operator who operates multiple facilities in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition shall locate each facility.

The operator's identity, marked as provided in subdivision (1) of this subsection, in the area where the proposed excavation or demolition is to occur. At a minimum, the operator's identity shall be marked at the beginning point, at intervals of 200 linear feet, and at the end point of the proposed excavation or demolition.

PeeDee-

Lot of new construction in all seven counties where PeeDee is located. New homes, trailers, tiny houses. Poultry house construction has slowed down. Roughly twelve more to go. Biogas conversion plant should begin in late November. In service date is supposed to be in 2020. Burnsville substation on Race Track Road is in progress. Grading started yesterday. Pole replacements, about fifty, to be done on Stanback Ferry, Ingram Mountain Road, Wall Street, and Hwy 109. PeeDee will also be putting an electric car charging station downtown in Wadesboro.

Cablehound-

Tickets for Duke Net are coming in. NCDOT tickets coming in for work on US74 from Dollar General to Anson High School garage. Getting some excavation tickets and a few survey tickets coming in. Other than that business as usual.

Piedmont Natural Gas-

A lot of maintenance work right now. Plastic pipe going in on Salisbury to replace steel will probably be done in 2020, not enough time to be done this year. Projects are funded and then money is re-allocated to other projects.
