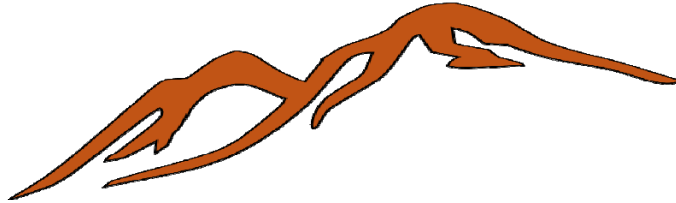

Open Discussion Reports

- A. **NC 811 / One Call** Brian provided us with the monthly 811 update. Also Brian talked to us about 811 having 811 come to your office and do an 811 Safety Presentation. Brian Morehouse went over the December 2020 presentation giving the totals for YTD and Monthly number for Tickets called in, average locates per day and (3) hour tickets. (This is included as a PDF on the UCC website) Went over the 2019 Call-Ins with all in attendance. Giving final numbers. 811 took in over 2.2. million tickets for the entire year with over 12 Million Transmissions. Very busy year for all. Reviewed with the group the (3) Hour tickets and we looked over how that number for the month of December has come down in majority

of the areas. Brian Morehouse went over the need to keep growing our UCC. Handed out cards for all to take and hand out to their contractors inviting them to the UCC meeting with times/dates. It was also addressed how the UCC will be stepping up on running their UCC, each UCC needs to have a Chairman, Co-Chairman, Secretary. It was mentioned that everyone could take the time to take notes for each meeting. Brian Morehouse has been doing this for the UCC. Very good feedback about locates within the area with no major issues to report at this time.

- B. **N.C.D.O.T – Bridge work continues throughout the area; it was reported that certain projects may be put on hold due to the budget. Small bridge work will continue with general maintenance and culvert repairs still on schedule. 221 work is continuing and is going along well and staying on schedule as given**
- C. **Skyline Communications- No major work to report, no report of major damages reported since October.**
- D. **Blue Ridge EMC- # Phase work continues of a 3-mile line. (1) Substation upgrade continues and will be going on through 2020.**
- E. **USIC- Tickets have been completed on time in area, reported that there have been a few issues with contractors expecting more then what they have requested on their ticket and then calling in a (3) Hour Ticket. Very informative information given for the area.**
