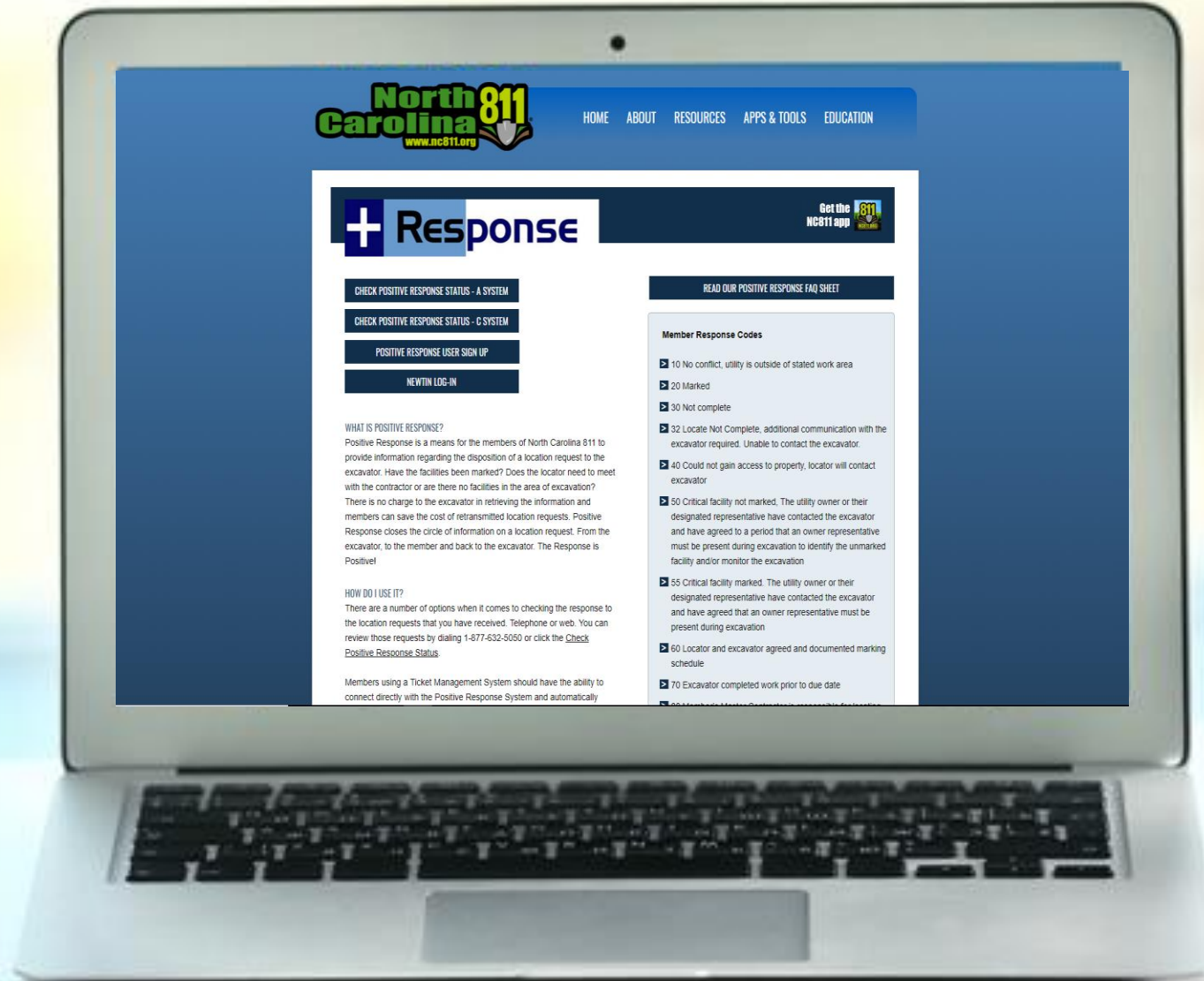

Meeting opened at 10:02 am by Chair, Richard Lawrence.

Level one safety protocol given by Richard Lawrence.

NCDOT-

Hwy 321 widening project through Division 12. Bridge replacements, eight in works, seven more in the design phase, may be ready later this year, possibly into 2019. I40/I77 projects ongoing. Lot of widening and improvements through Catawba Valley and Startown Road. Six to eight secondary bridge replacements coming as well. There will be sixteen roundabouts throughout Catawba County and sixteen throughout Lincoln County.

Neill Grading-They are really busy. Working all over the place, mostly out of town. Project at First Presbyterian. Finishing up at Hickory City Park. Will be doing grading and site work for some apartments and residential in Huntersville/Mecklenburg around Beatties Ford Road. Jan said he was impressed with the design work he has been seeing from builders. Much more thoughtful design for utility layouts.

Heath Consultants-

Very few past due tickets. Appreciate everyone's patience. Introduced new lead tech. Jennifer will be doing locates for Mears.

PSNC-

Two services in Taylorsville coming up. New McDonalds and a new business at the old Hardees building.

City of Newton-

New water line on Fie Drive just completed. Sewer replacement on South Cedar Street should be completed in a few days. Buffalo Shoals and Balls Creek water line extension.

City of Lincoln-
City of Lincoln-

200 unit apartment complex at Buffalo Shoals Road is close to completion. There is a Chik-Fil-A restaurant coming at the 321/27 intersection.

City of Hickory-

Downtown work. There is a \$20 million dollar walkway coming. Bids are to go out in May.

Bigham Cable-

Ten major projects in the Denver area. Four more projects coming, haven't not been released yet. Will update once they have the information. They are having some issues getting locates done on time and making sure they are correct.

Piedmont Natural Gas-

Hoping they are close to being complete on the 321 line to Lenoir. A lot of maintenance work is in progress. They have had a few small service line cuts (damages).
