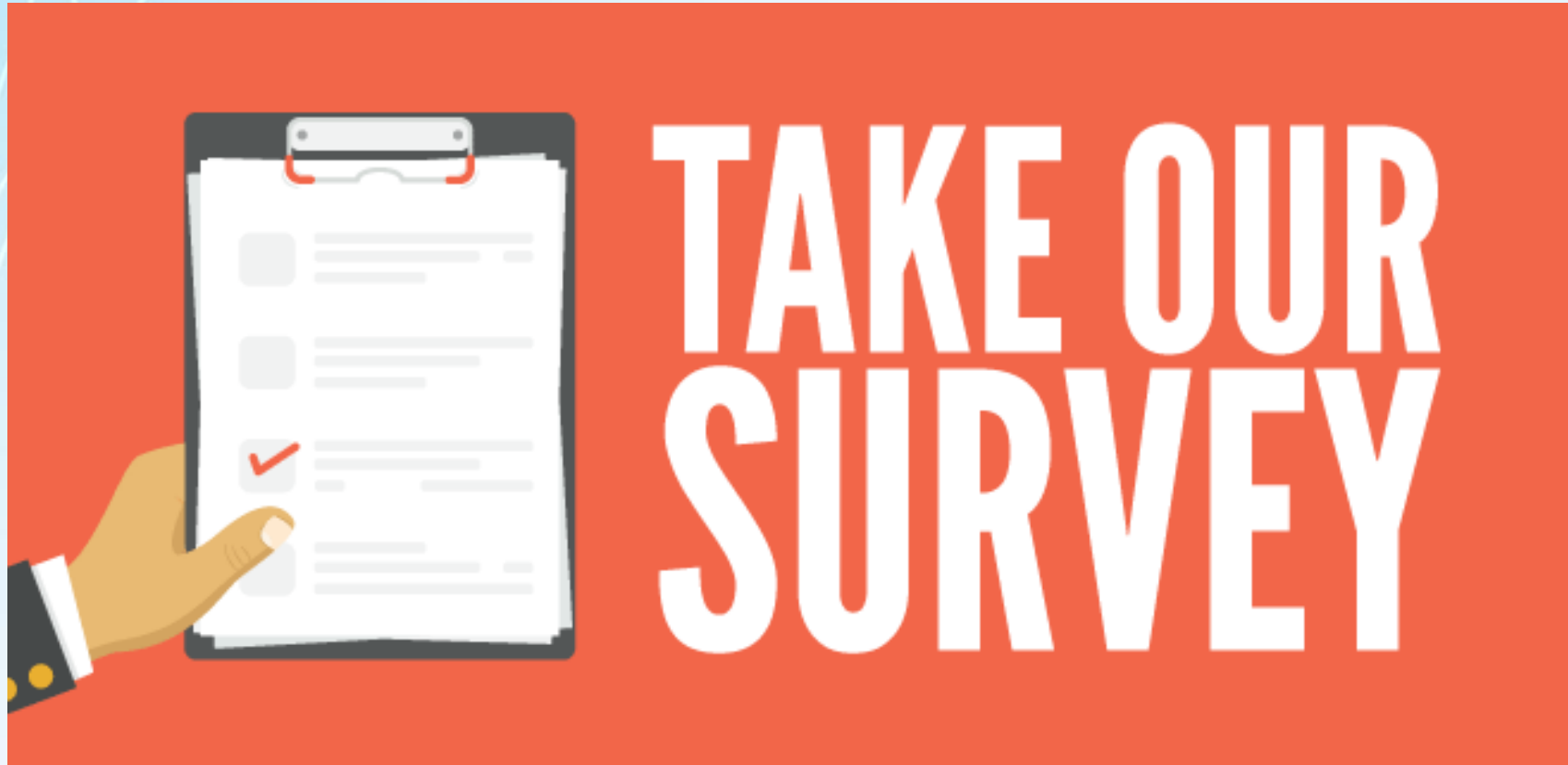

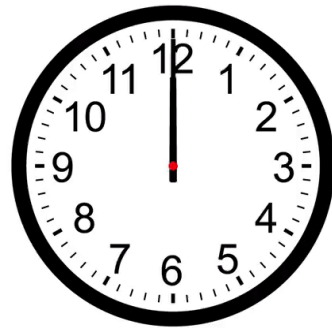
# 3 Hour Notice vs Destroyed Marks
