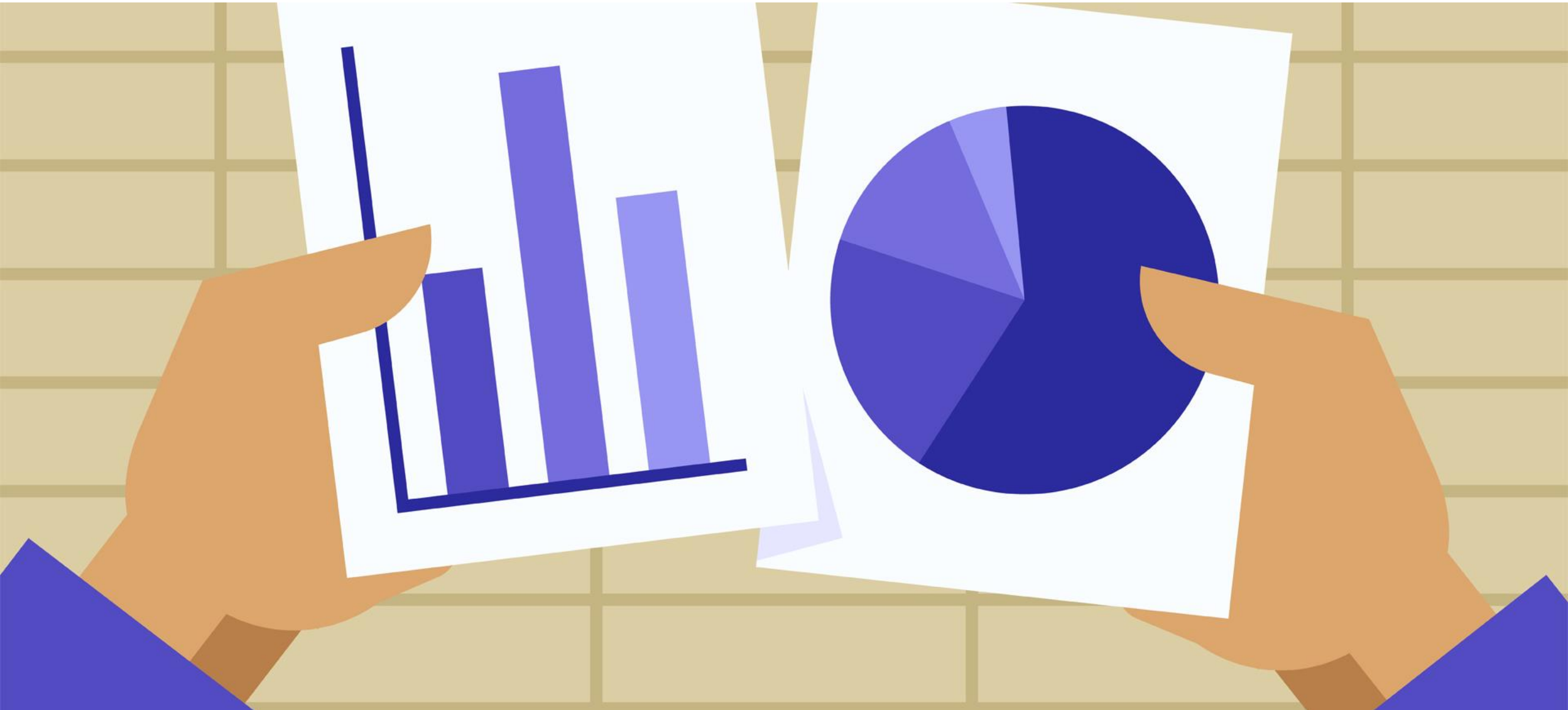

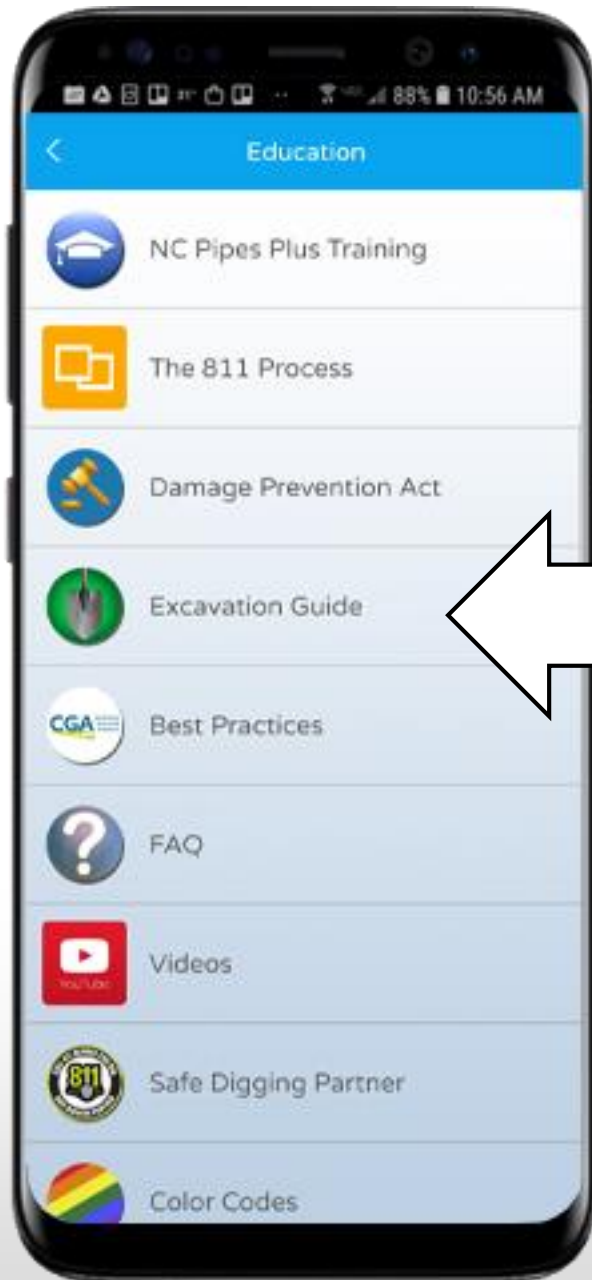

Buncombe March 2019 UCC Meeting

Meeting called to order by Jenny Stamney- Chairwomen UCC- AT&T

Meeting started at 12:05 PM

Brian Morehouse, Western Region Education Liaison, gave the March 2019 Presentation.

Gave the overall stats for this area for the Month of February 2019 compared to the Month of February 2018, gave the YTD totals. A short video was shown to the group in regards to calling 811 Before You Dig!! The video showed an incident that involved a gas company and what can happen when someone doesn't Call 811 Before You Dig!!!

Brian Morehouse told the group that there are openings throughout the year if anyone is interested in having 811 come in and speak to their organization about 811, when, why and how to contact 811. Also, went over the new 811 app, encourage all to download the app.

Went over with the group on how to navigate the app and showing them how to get to the Damage Prevention portion of the app.

Brian Morehouse went over with the group that if they have any issues to make sure to reach out to him with those issues and please don't wait to the meeting to address them. Reason- he doesn't want to have them waiting two or three weeks to get an issues resolved, he would like to jump on it ASAP

811 talked to the group about special events and meeting coming up in April,

Old Business- Brian Morehouse went over items that he had noticed in the field with all in attendance. He stated that he has been getting a few calls from contractors stating that they are having to call in (3) hr locates after they receive their Positive Response back stating that all facilities were marked as requested.

NC811 also spoke to the group about Pipes Plus Training, if anyone is still interested please contact Brian Morehouse to schedule a class for your organization.

New Business

PSNC- Staying bust with new installs and retirement of old pipe. Locates they have seen an increase and are on top of locating as needed.

Southern Cross- Having issues with Universal Contractor putting in Fiber cable calling in (3) hr tickets, they will go out on site and everything is marked. Brian Morehouse will reach out to contractor and go over issues. Reported that they are very busy and will be adding another locator in April 2019. They had cut two locators in January 2019. Reports of bad white lining not the same as ticket, also was Universal whom is doing work for AT &T

MSD- Large project continues over near the Biltmore with new line installation

Asheville Water- North Fork Dam Project is under way and will continue thru summer
