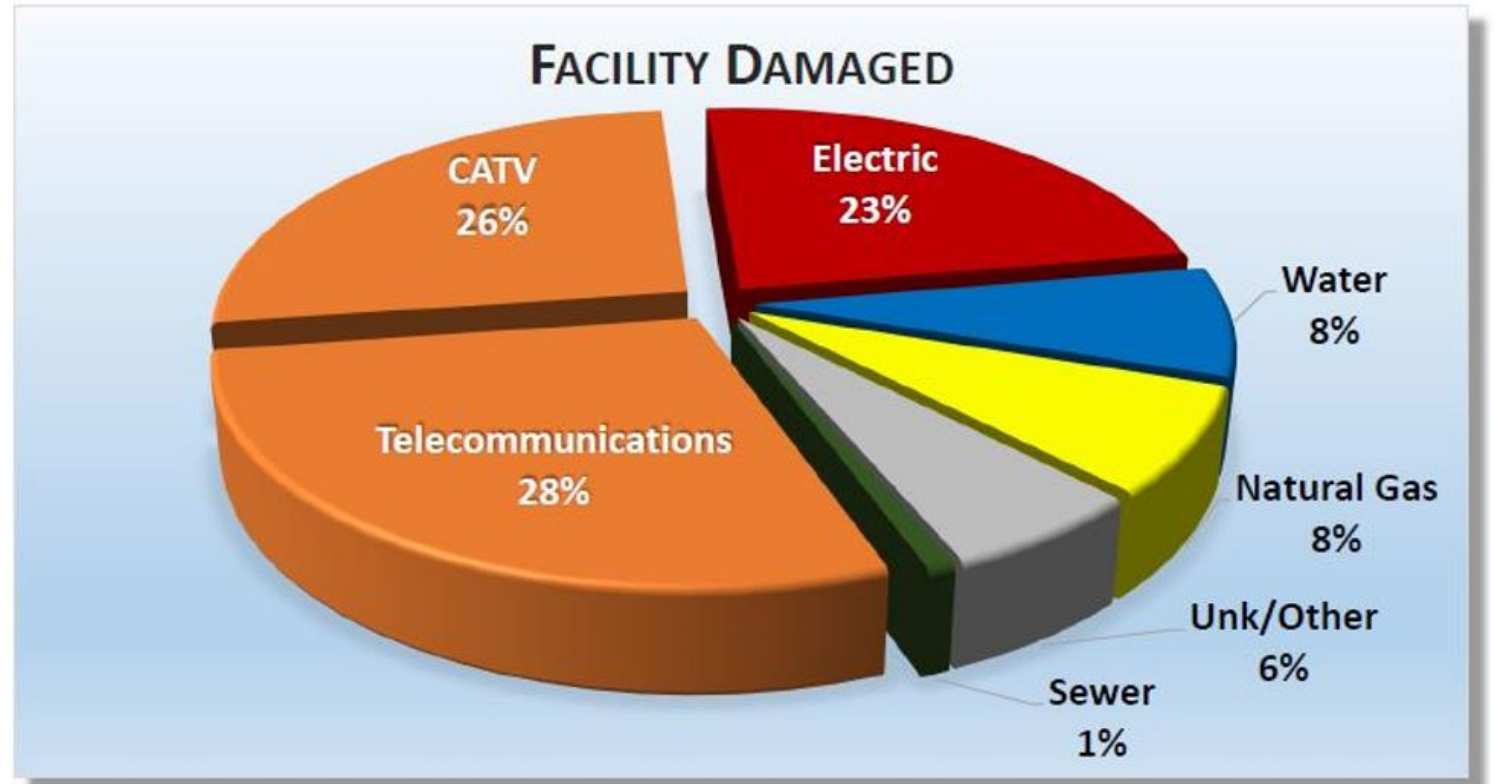

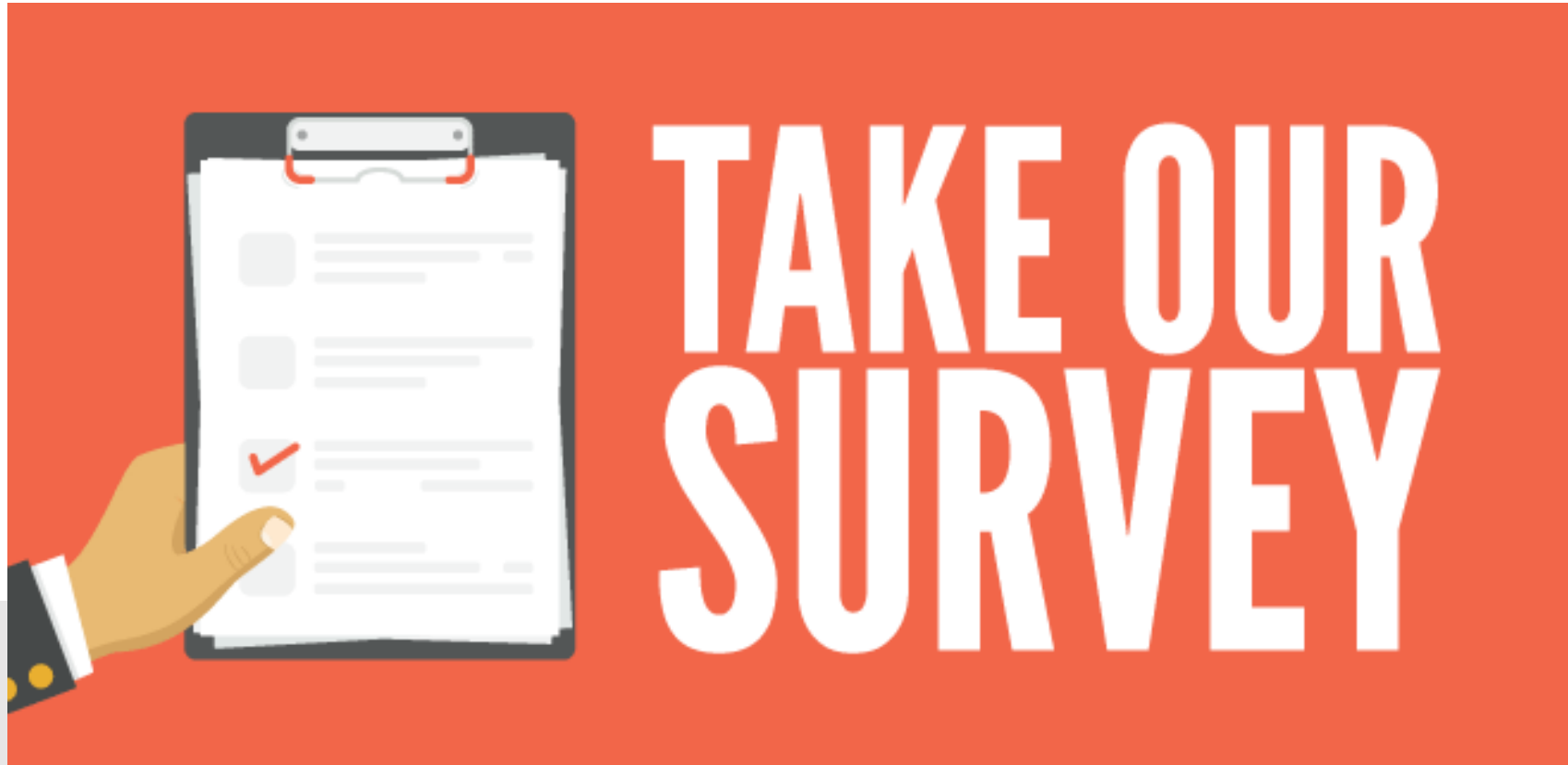

Half of All Damages Occur in Summer

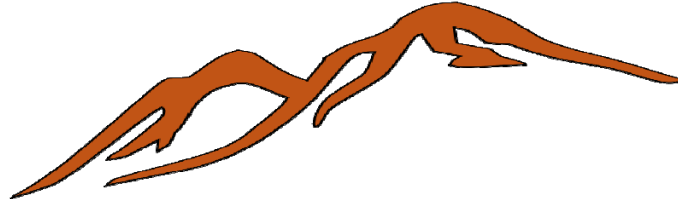
50 percent of reported damages occurred between June and September in 2017.

- Topic – Clear Locate instructions make locating more efficient.
- Went over the YTD and April 2018/2019 Numbers for (3) Hour Tickets, New Tickets, RXMT and Updates, giving the totals show in the presentation given (will be listed on the website to review)
- 1st Quarter Incident Report given among the 83 counties in NC. A break down was given for all utilities.

- NC 811 / One Call presentation was given by: Brian Morehouse
- All were encouraged to become Safe Digging Partners and to download the 811 App. Everyone was shown how to do both of these procedures.

Open Discussion

- Discussion was made about locates not being marked on time and what can be done about it. Brian Morehouse went over how you have to contact 811 wait the required three days to be marked, checked Postitive Response, and if you area has not been marked to call in a (3) hour ticket

Reports

- A. **NC 811 / One Call** – Brian provided us with the monthly 811 update. Also Brian talked to us about 811 having a successful safe digging month (April.) 811 has noticed a major increase in tickets this year.

PSNC-Dominion Energy- Locates are up and they are staying very busy at this time. They are using all locators to be out and to help with locates. They are staying on top of things.

ESC- Nothing to report at this time

MSD- Continues on their large project that will continue into July 2019. Doing a small ¾ mile job on the northern end of the county.

NC DOT- Reported that large projects continue to come in with widening, shoulder work, sign replacement, rail guard being replaced. Bridge work continues to be heavy. Was reported having an issue with getting locates down on time and being marked correctly. Brian Morehouse gave them the numbers of the locators within this area to reach out too so they are able to get this jobs marked as needed.

Southern Cross Locators- Have added another locator, business is rather heavy but they are staying on top of matters. (locating)
