Meeting was called to order by President, Ralph Johnson. Troy Houser of Brentwood Water Corp. offered a prayer of blessings on the meeting and meal.

Mark Schuman could not be with us this month, however he sent his presentation to me which I sent out in a separate email on Saturday, July 8, 2017.

**Please review the presentation for specific data concerning the statistics during June 2017.**

**Round-table Discussion Time:**

Mike Sheffield PRT Consulting: Reported that they have had three damages reported in Caldwell County, they were caused by the locators not following proper procedures.

David Perkins - Brentwood Water: Recent storms have caused a lot of damage to the Brentwood system. Damages to two buster pumps at the Jenkins' Road pump house. Also lightning hit the antenna on the tank on Crawley Dale Facility. Beginning to encounter several water line leaks. Sold two taps over the past few weeks.

Will Dennis – Town of Rhodhiss: Finally beginning to see some work being done on their water and sewage project. Material is being delivered now. Buckeye Bridge Construction is doing the work on this project. The Grant received was for \$2.7 million.

Shane Stines – City of Morganton: Have experienced a lot of power outages and damage to their systems from the many severe storms that have occurred over the past several days and weeks.

John Leger - Town of Rutherford College: Fuller Construct of Cherryville is the contractor on their grant project. Also, they have begun a project to do GIS mapping on all their water and sewage lines throughout their system. This project is to be completed by Mid-October.

Ken & Doug Suttles - Suttles Surveying: Currently doing a lot of commercial work. They are doing survey projects on Old Fort School, Mountain View School, and East Burke Elementary School. Doug Suttles pointed out that there are a lot of construction projects where the “as built” development of the survey plats is being done. He stated that to protect our systems, we need to ensure that we obtain certified surveys so the items listed are official and will stand up in the event of legal action requirements.

Brent Thompson - Charter Cable: Business is good, mostly routine. Installing several residential lines over the past several weeks.
