<u>Josh Stigler – USIC</u>: Told the group that today's meeting was his last meeting. His company is transferring him to Pennsylvania beginning Monday, November 20th.

Josh reported that because of the upcoming holidays, that locates are down a little. He says that they have been able to keep up with the current volume. He also reported that someone will be replacing him in this position. He is going to send the contact information to the secretary, so they can be included in future distributions of information.

<u>Doug Suttles - Suttles Surveying</u>: Still doing a lot of commercial and contract type work. They have been working on an Assisted Living Complex off East Parker Road in Morganton. Their work continues the Hampton Inn project in Black Mountain.

<u>David Perkins - Brentwood Water:</u> Still have some leakages to deal with. The leaks are slowing down a little. We are still selling new water taps. Currently working with the NC DOT on replacements of guard railing on many highways in the county. This is creating a lot of work in trying to keep this project for damaging their systems pipelines.

Recently Brentwood Water Corp was working on a water line leak on the Jamestown Road. This project had been located by USIC. They failed to locate a fiber optic line, in which was almost cut during the digging process. Had it not been for the warning tape buried above the line, there would have been a major cut in this fiber line. This situation was reported to NC811.

<u>David Poore – West Consultants:</u> Currently working on major water line replacement projects for the Town of Rutherford College. Also working on projects in Surry County.

<u>Tom Chapman – REMC:</u> Recently held their annual membership meeting. It was very well attended. The Morganton Office of REMC is in the process of building new offices on Carbon City Road, in Morganton. These new offices will be an addition to their current facilitates. REMC experienced some damages in the Hwy 18 South for recent Tornados passing through the area. They had to replace 76 poles and lines.


