<u>Richard Deal – USIC:</u> "Still staying busy. Still Hiring and training new employees. Having problems retaining employees, due to drug testing, leaving to go to other employment and other reasons. Google projects are starting to pick up again in the area. The Highway 16

project for Newton-Conover to Charlotte is really draining their resources. Seeing all utilities upgrading their systems in this project.

<u>David Poore – West Consultants:</u> Currently working on projects for the Town of Rutherford College and the Town of Rhodhiss.

<u>Will Dennis – Town of Rhodhiss</u>: They have begun their water and sewage projects for which they received grant monies. This project is a long term one, and is presently around 13% completed.

<u>John Leger - Town of Rutherford College</u>: Still selling new taps for projects in their area. The Bojangles project is now underway near I-40 intersection.




