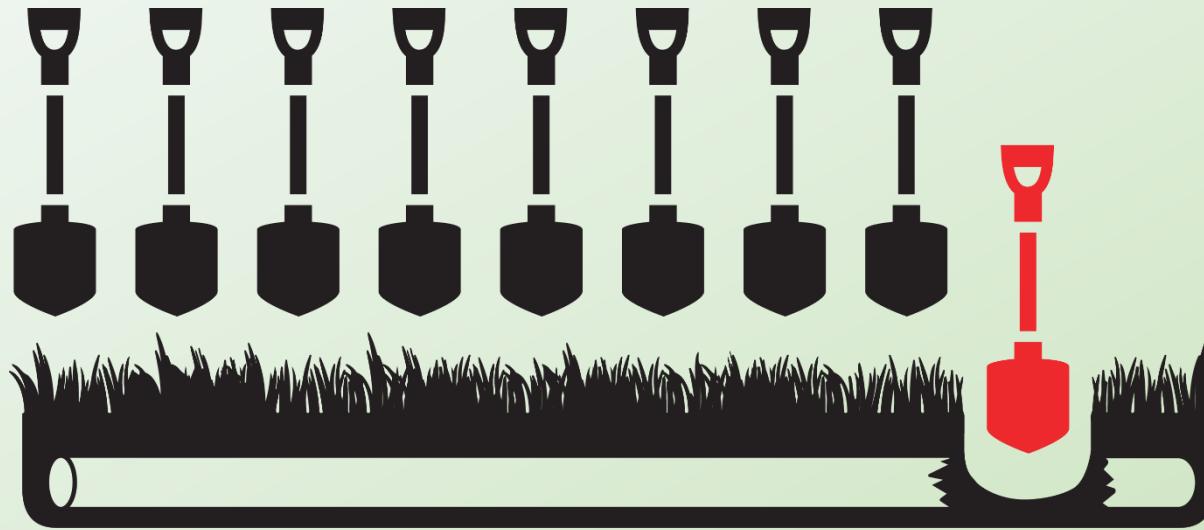

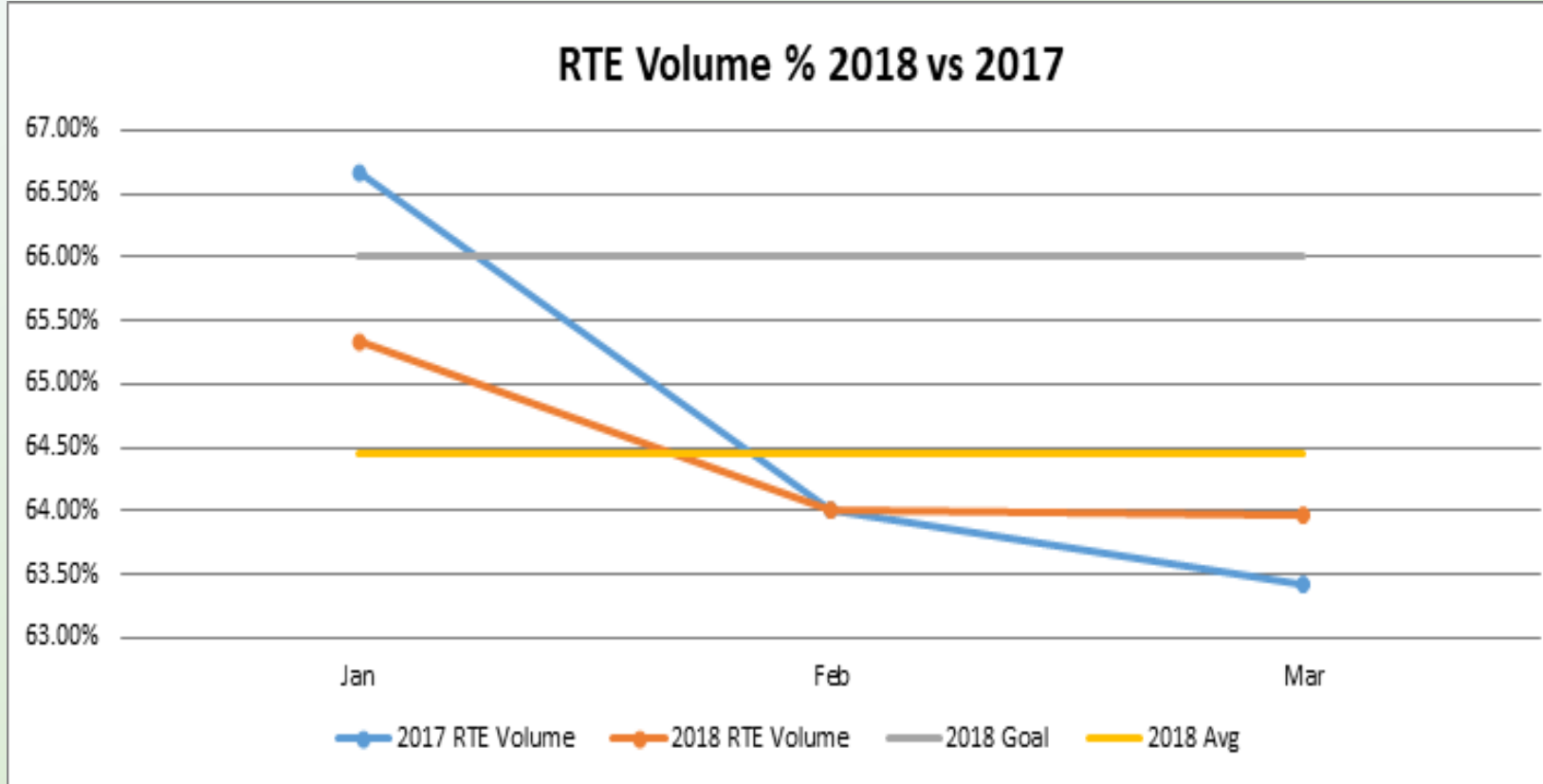

Brian Morehouse of NC811 UCC made the presentation for the month of March 2018. **The entire presentation was sent to you early last week. Or you can find it by visiting the NC811 website at - <http://www.nc811.org/>**

Brian noted that Ingles Super Markets, Home Depot, and Lowes Home Improvements are sponsors of NC 811 Safe Digging this spring in all their garden centers. Look for the 811 logos on plants at these locations.

RTE – (Remote Ticket Entry System): If you are not using RTE to notify NC 811, you should be looking at this process. There is training required to use this system, however is it very easy to get the training. This method of request locates is quick and easy to use. Give Brian a call to help get your training and save yourself a lot of time.

Round-table Discussion Time:

Ken Suttles & Doug Suttles - Suttles Surveying: Trying to hire new employees, very hard to find folks who have any qualifications and willing to work.

David Perkins - Brentwood Water: Still selling new taps. Seems to be a lot of new constructions going on right now. Still have some leaks to be repaired and maintenance to be done.

David Wortman – Town of Rhodhiss: Still digging rock on their major water and sewage projects. Estimate that the water project is approximately 30% complete. They also have received another grant for some additional inter-structure projects.

Tom Chapman – REMC: Doing a lot of maintenance and clean up projects. The building being built in Morganton, is going well. Should see walls to begin being built over the next few weeks.

Shane Stines - City of Morganton: Nothing to report. Shane stated that he will be going to a different job within the City. Roger Allen will be replacing him doing locations for the city.

Jennifer Henderson - Heath Consultants: Nothing to report.

Keith Radcliff – NC DOT: Jointed us for this meeting. He is located out of Buncombe county. He covers the area down through Burke County. A lot of work being done on I-40 over the next few years.

David Poore – West Consultants: Working on a large sub-division (500+ lots) just across the Lake Rhodhiss in Caldwell County. Major sewage and water inter-structure. Currently have seven major projects in the works.

David Breland – USIC: Things are going smoothly in this area. Have a full crew for the Burke County area.

Our next meeting will be held again on Tuesday, May 8, 2018 at 12:00 noon at the Timberwood Restaurant in Morganton. Hope to see you next month!!
