Mark Schuman comments and his presentation was given. Below are some of the details from That presentation:

1. April is National Safe Digging Month. Mark noted that there are currently 48 UCC chapters which covers 84 of the 100 counties in North Carolina. He also reported that he has begun a new UCC chapter in Madison County.

Burk County has a total of 1,088 Tickets during March, Caldwell Had a total of 651 tickets during March.

<u>Remote Tickets for March 2017</u>: Total of 172,000 Total tickets, of this number 63,000 were called in, and 109,000 were done through Remote Ticket entry.

Damage Report for first quarter: Burke County had 2 damages reported. Caldwell County had 3 damages reported. With a total statewide, of 653 reported damages to NC811 UCC.

- 3. <u>Lowes 811 Partners for 2017:</u> Their 1,840 Store locations nationwide are applying over 1.5 million "Tree Wraps" advertising 811 Program to ever tree they sell during 2017 planting season.
- 4. Reminder that the NC811 app is available for your smart phone applications. This is a good app for members to be using.

Round-table Discussion Time:

<u>Shane Stines – City of Morganton:</u> Working on sub-station #3 near the new Mountain View School. A lot of lines and work is required to be moved for the construction and location of this school project.

<u>Tom Chapman - REMC</u>: Not much is going on. REMC is going to build new offices in Carbon City at the site of the old motel next to their current offices. The old offices will be used for other purposes.

<u>David Wortman – Town of Rhodhiss:</u> Nothing going on now. Hope to see some activity begin with the grant money for a new water construction project by next month.

<u>David Perkins - Brentwood Water:</u> We are continuing our current exercising valves project within the system. We try to do this at least every other year. Several thousand values to be turned. We are currently caught up on new tap installations and leaks.

<u>Ken Suttles & Doug Suttles - Suttles Surveyors</u>: They too are working on the new school project in Morganton. They are also working on a project at the Old Fort Elementary School in Old Fort, NC.

<u>Special Note</u>: Doug & Ken Suttles invite the Burke / Caldwell Counties NC 811 UCC group to join the McDowell County member any month at the Countryside Barbeque Restaurant in Marion, NC on the 3rd Monday of each month at 11:30 AM. <u>McDowell Chapter will not meet next</u> <u>week!</u>

<u>John Leger – Town of Rutherford College:</u> Still working on a sewage problem within the town. Also, dealing with a few leaks and a DOT Signage project within the town limits.

<u>Richard Deal & Mike Sheffield – USIC</u>: Still staying **real busy**. They are still hiring new locators, and doing training session every two to three weeks. Lots of work to be done! Richard reported that he currently has over 900 locates to do. They can stay busy 7 days a week and not get caught up.


