<u>Shane Stines – City of Morganton:</u> Nothing to report.

<u>Ken & Doug Suttles - Suttles Surveying</u>: Currently doing a lot of commercial work. Several motel projects site surveys in Boone, and Black Mountain.

<u>Richard Deal – USIC:</u> "Still staying busy. Still Hiring and training new employees. Workload has slowed down some. The rainy weather we are experiencing now will put workload further behind."


