Round-table Discussions:

<u>Tommy Chapman – REMC:</u> Continuing to work on the 100,000 voltage Transmission lines between Cathy Road and US Highway 64 South. REMC has begun to pull wire for this project. If all goes well, this project should be completed by years end. The experienced a lot of wind damage and power outage from the recent wind and storm of a few weeks ago.

<u>David Wortman – Town of Rhodhiss:</u> Nothing to report.

<u>Ralph Johnson – Brentwood Water:</u> Doing routine maintenance to equipment and the system. Getting ready for the winter month that are upon us. Still selling new taps and fixing some leaks. Have completed the painting of the water tank on Hwy 70 West at Snow Hill.

<u>Ken & Doug Suttles – Suttles Surveying:</u> Still working on the Lake James dam project and DOT Bridge replacement on Sugar Hill Road at I-40 intersection. The Lake James project has been extended to early spring. The Powerhouse road across the dam is going to require rebuilding because of all the heavy traffic in the repairs made to the dam.

<u>Jeremy Hussey – USIC – Caldwell County:</u> The Facebook project in Caldwell County is about to be completed. Jeremy hopes to be able to report at our next meeting that this project is completed.

<u>John Leger – Town of Rutherford College:</u> Several new houses are being built in the Harbor Ridge development. Lots of new taps along with regular maintenance to their system.
