Round-table Discussion Time:

<u>Richard Deal & Daniel Breland – USIC:</u> Richard reported that PNG has gone with another provider for locating services as of January 1, 2018. This supplier is Heath Consultants for Texas. He noted that Heath Consultants have been have some problems with their locates.

The bad weather has slowed down the locates. They have had 68 tickets issued over a oneweek period for this area for frozen water line repairs.

USIC is still hiring new locators, and has a train class beginning next week. They are still able to manage the ticket workload.

Mike Sheffield - PRG Consulting: Nothing to report.

<u>Ken Suttles & Doug Suttles - Suttles Surveying</u>: Still staying very busy. They are working on a new retirement home project on Parker Road in Morganton. They are still working on the Hotel project in Black Mountain.

<u>David Perkins - Brentwood Water</u>: Things have been slow during the cold weather. Brentwood has not experienced any leaks on their main lines from the cold weather. Now that the weather is warming up, we have had over 100 customers calling in with leaks on their side of the meters caused by the cold weather.

<u>David Poore – West Consultants:</u> Still working on two projects in the towns of Rhodhiss and Rutherford College.

<u>Will Dennis – Town of Rhodhiss:</u> Still working on the water and sewage grant project. Approximately 23% of the work on the water lines has been done.

<u>Shawn Kelly – Badger Inc.</u>: December has been a very slow month. Beginning to do some work in the Lenoir, Rutherford Collage, and Morganton areas.

<u>Tom Chapman – REMC</u>: REMC has experienced a record usage of power over the last 2 days. This is going to cause customers to have larger power bills.

<u>Shane Stines - City of Morganton</u>: Continental Teva electrical project was completed over New Year's holiday. The city has experienced a lot of water leaks due to the cold weather. They also had several electrical transformers to go out of service and had to be replaced.
