

Brian Morehouse of NC811 UCC made the presentation of data for the month of February 2019. The stats for the month of February are included in his presentation.

Brian Morehouse's Comments:

- He reminded the group that if you have not already done so, that you need to download the 811 App and begin using the remote ticket entry. It is very easy to use, and the app has everything that you need to successfully communicate with NC 811.
- Also, please communicate to him any issues we may have that is causing delays in get the locates done in a timely fashion.

• January Tickets Info: Total in 2019: 167,000 tickets 2018: 1502,000 tickets

• **Burke County:** Averaged 51 tickets/day. With a -2.2% decrease.

• Caldwell County: Averaged 51 tickets/day. With a 41% increase

• Remote Tickets: Everyone needs to start using the Remote Ticket request from the App. It is a lot faster, and very easy to use.

- Everyone is invited to go on the app and become a "Safe Digging Partner". By doing so, you will receive 811 logos for your equipment, trucks etc. This will help greatly to advertise the 811 "Call Before You Dig" environment.
- Brian requested that if our companies or organizations has a website, that we consider

- Brian wants to visit with our companies and go out into the field to see what we do.
 Also, if there is anything, he can do to help you. Please call him!
- Finally, NC 811 is setting up booths at many of the local Lowes Improvement Center to make their customers aware of the need to "Call before you dig"!

• Round-table Discussions:

<u>Tom Chapman – REMC:</u> Staying very busy. Working continues on maintenance items. The new Morganton Operations Office should be opening around the week of March 18th. This is going to be a great addition to REMC facilities.

<u>Mile Champion – Burke County:</u> The are working a water project on NC Hwy 18 South of I-40. This is approximately five miles of water line installation.

<u>John Leger – Town of Rutherford College</u>: Not much is going on. Still installing a few new taps and dealing with a small number of water line leaks.

<u>Will Dennis – Town of Rhodhiss</u>: The are now closing out their large grant project of sewage and water line installation. This new system is working really well!

<u>David Poore – West Consulting</u>: Their company is the engineering company for Burke County's Hwy 18 water line expansion program. They are also working on a project for the Town of Valdese.

<u>David Perkins - Brentwood Water:</u> Weather has caused a lot of delays in projects and maintenance work. Continuing to work on the updating our GIS mapping system for the entire Brentwood Water System. This is an ongoing project, that is going to take at least 12 to 15 months to complete. "We work on it when things are going well, and the workload is not so heavy". Once completed, we will have a complete GIS Mapping System for our entire Water System.

<u>Doug Suttles – Suttles Surveying:</u> They are very busy. Quoting on 5 to 10 projects on a daily basis. Most of these projects are 12 weeks to 6 months out.

<u>Tracy Billington – Bigham Cable:</u> The too have a lot of work going on. They have at least 100+ jobs at all times. Most of this work is in Caldwell and Catawba Counties. They have a large job going on NC Hwy 16.

<u>Jeremy Hussy - USIC:</u> Has just been assigned to the Caldwell County area for USIC Locating Services.

Max Chapman, member of Brentwood Water Corporation Board of Directors was honored today by NC 811 for his thirty-five plus year of service to Brentwood Water Corporation and membership in the Burke / Caldwell Counties NC 811 UCC Association.
