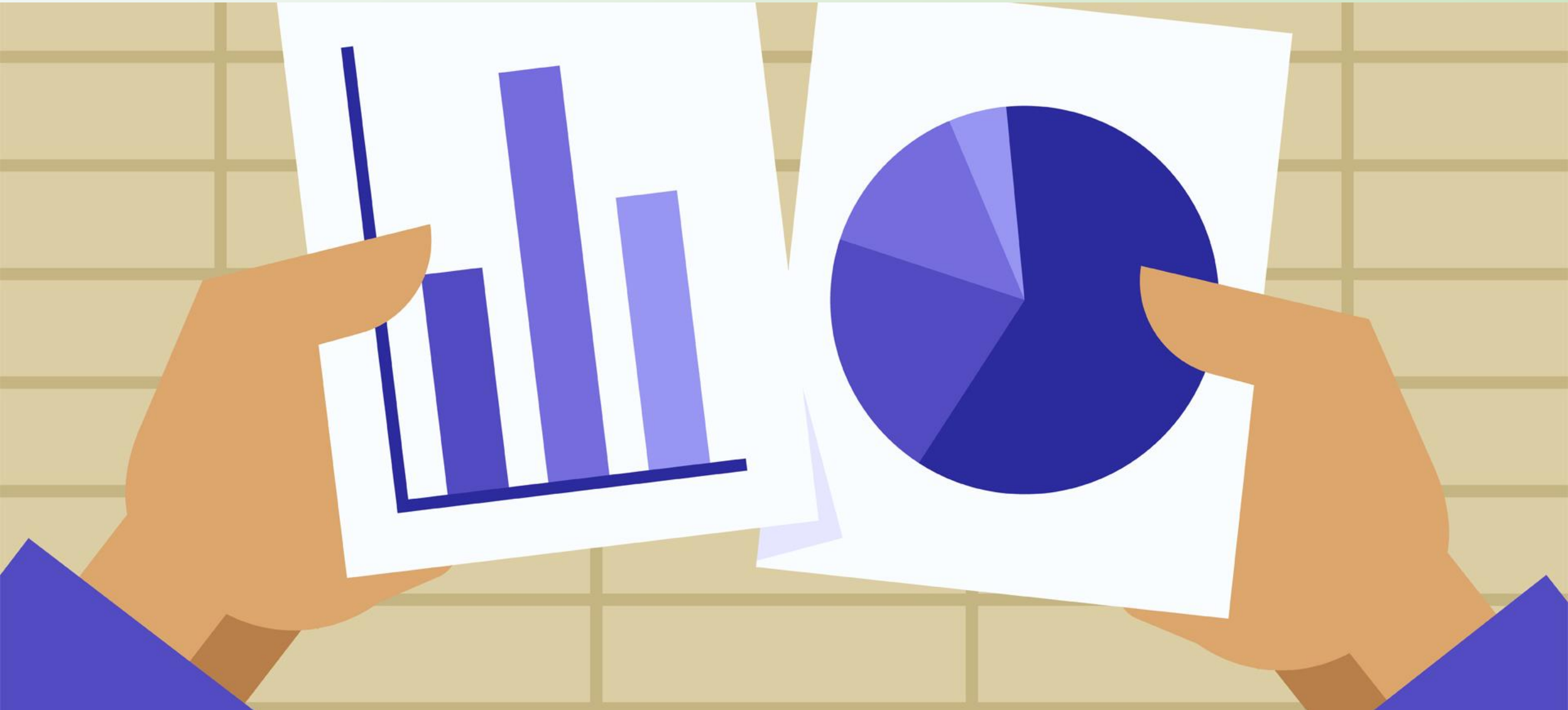

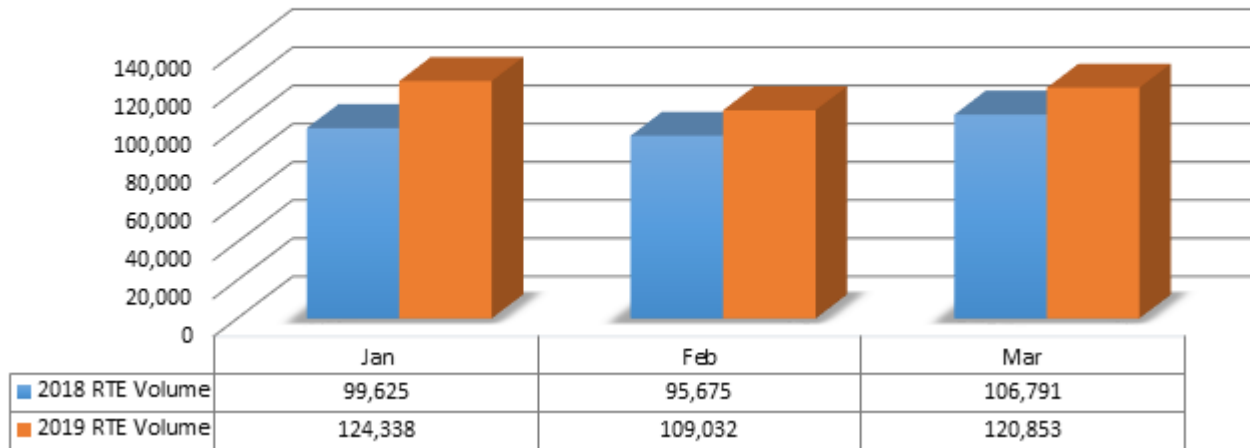

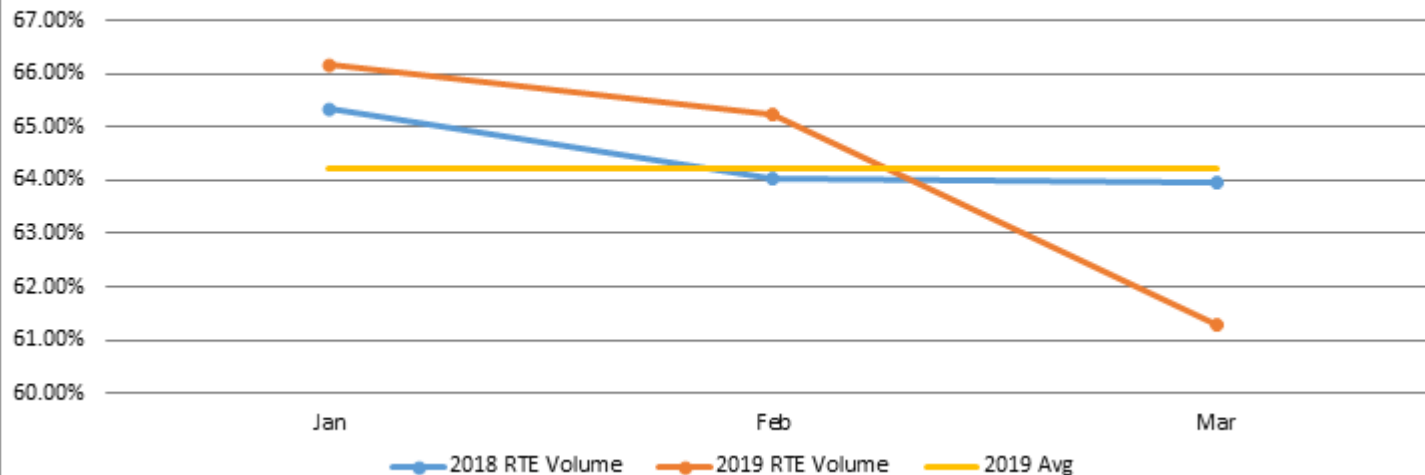


RTE Volume 2019 vs 2018
