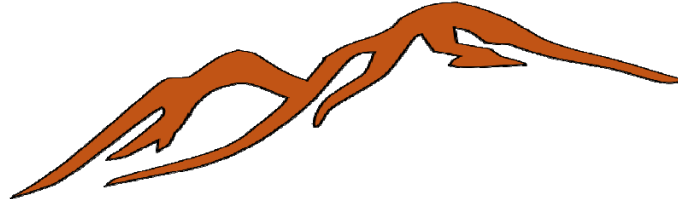

New Business

- NC 811 / One Call presentation was given by: Brian Morehouse, Western Region Education Liaison. : Brian Morehouse went over Emergency calls, how to put an Emergency in on line if your RTE qualified. Encouraged those that put in 50 or more tickets a month to become RTE users. Those that don't were shown how to put tickets in through SAT off of the NC811.org website and NC811 APP.

- **Reported that locate issues have cleared up over the last (3) months and doing well with communication.**

- A. **NC 811 / One Call** – – Brian provided us with the monthly 811 update. Also Brian talked to us about 811 having 811 come to your office and do an 811 Safety Presentation. Brian Morehouse went over the December 2019 presentation giving the totals for YTD and Monthly number for Tickets called in, average locates per day and (3) hour tickets. (This is included as a PDF on the UCC website) Brian went over how to donate to the Food Banks and other organization to help those in need. Encourage all of those in attendance to help others during the Holiday season. NC811 went over some of the new laws and procedures that are now in effect as of October 1st 2019. Showed a short video on 2019 the Year in Review. Brian Morehouse brought to everyone's attention the ¼ mile, 1,320' or (5) adjoining properties law, and also discussed the single address rule. Went over in great detail. NC811 also went over upcoming events within the next few months. Brian Morehouse encouraged all to attend these UCC meetings. Brian Morehouse went over the NC811 App since we had new attendees. New Officers were elected- Barbara Lacey Chairman-. Chris Busby – Secretary and Tracey Co-Chairman. All re-elected for their positions
- B. **N.C.D.O.T** – Bridge work continues within the Dillsboro area. General Maint work is ongoing. The Hwy 64/74 project has begun and is expected to last through 2022. NCDOT will be widening that stretch of road with widening both sides of the road and a turning lane. Utilities starting NC69 Clay Court (4) Lane project
