The UCC Quarterly Meeting for June was held at the CenturyLink Building in downtown Clinton. There were 7 in attendance. The meeting was opened by Howard Corey. Mr. Corey presented a short video on "Safety with Kids". He also presented the NC811 report.

**Discussion**

**NCDOT Div. 6** – Rick Bounds with NCDOT stated they were working on Hwy 74 from Columbus County to Bladen County. They are also working on local projects that include drainage issues, etc. and still working to finish up damage from Hurricane Florence.

**NCDOT Div. 6** – John Walters also representing NCDOT Div. 6 stated they were also working on issues from the hurricane in Bladen County. They have completed 3 sites at this time with several more upcoming. They will be working on a project on Hwy 210 between 701 & 41 and 701 and 53.

**City of Clinton** – Russell Byrd with the City of Clinton stated the current phase of the NCDOT NC24 project (R2303D) in Clinton, is nearing completion. He noted that next phase, (R2303E) of the NCDOT NC24 project will include the removal and replacement of Faircloth Freeway Bridges as well as construction on a new alignment south and east of Clinton. Bids on this project phase (R2303E) are expected to be advertised in late 2019. He also mentioned NCDOT will be advertising for bids for milling and resurfacing College Street and Beamon Street next year. Mr. Byrd also mentioned upcoming City funded projects, including bidding tree root and joint repair, in lieu of annual resurfacing, later this year on City maintained streets. The City is also working with a consultant to prepare an Asset Management Plan under a NCDEQ Water and Sewer Asset Inventory Assessment grant of its water and sewer system, including mapping of adjacent drainage structures.

**Star Communications** – Carlie Raynor stated Star was working on several Fiber to the home projects. The Roseboro project is almost completed. Several Bridge projects are coming up on Edwin Mathis Rd., Peyton Daniels Rd., Greens Mill Rd. and Hollow Bridge Rd. to name a few.

The meeting was adjourned.

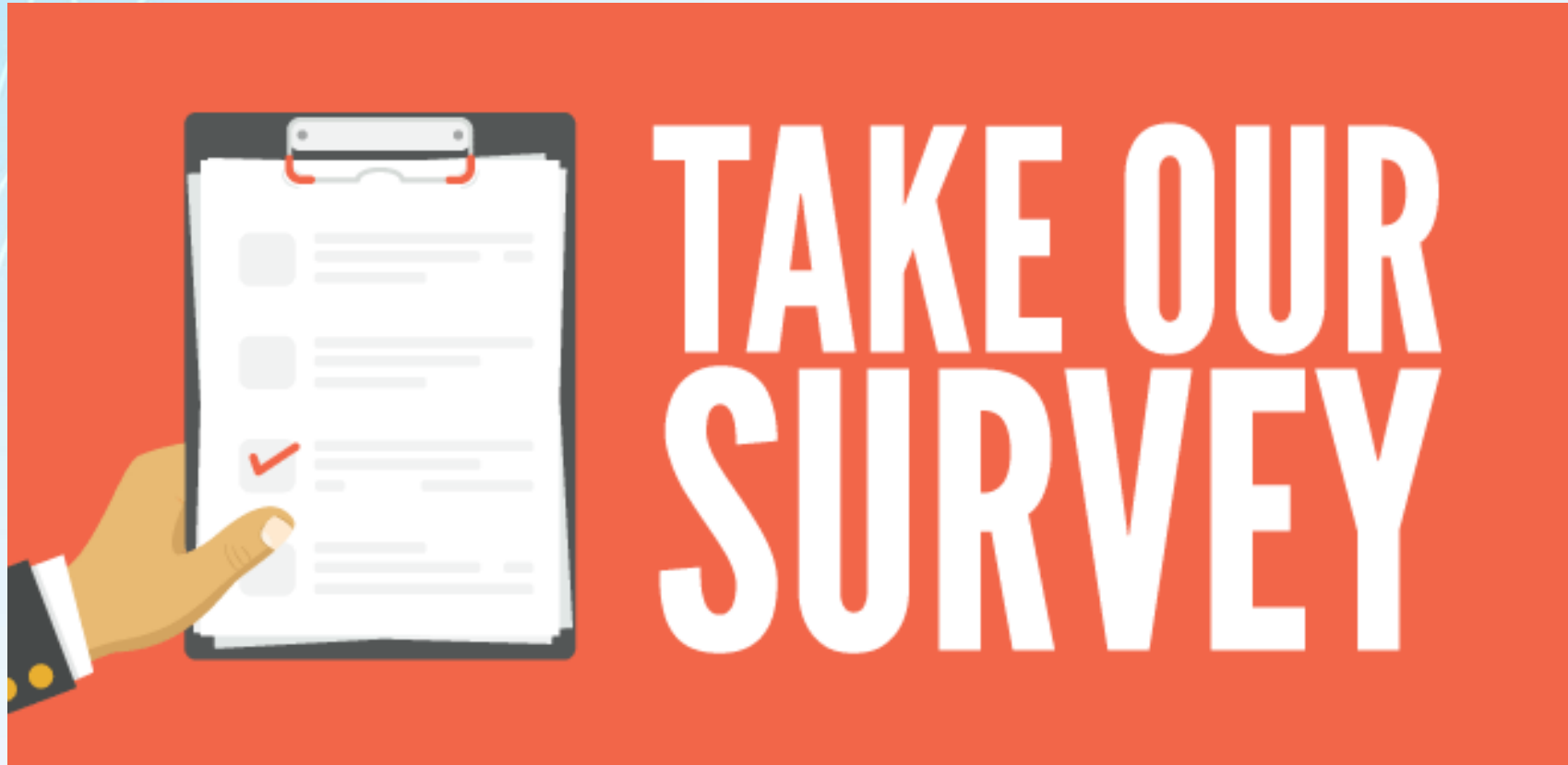

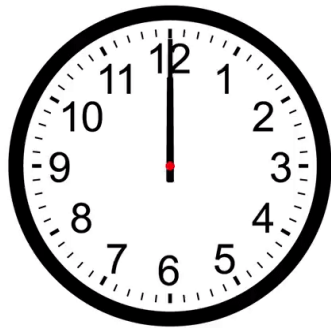
# 3 Hour Notice vs Destroyed Marks
