The meeting was called to order by Jennifer Miller

The safety moment was in reference to "A Man Down" what to do about communicating with co-workers for safety.

Jeff Bartley rolled out the NC811 presentation for Durham ticket numbers. He talked about cross bores, we are doing more directional bores than ever.

Billy Miller stated that PSNC spots the lines before they bore is the policy with their crews.

James Shawver talked about having a job that he couldn't start due to couldn't get a job marked and wasn't willing to risk hitting a line and the area was completely in concrete/asphalt.

Tim stated that the volume in tickets should be increasing soon but will not be nowhere near like last year.

Jeff Bartley talked about destroyed marks vs. 3 hour ticket and what the difference is.

Dig law states that destroyed marks does not extend the life of a ticket.

If a locator pulls up his photos that he marked a line, he is not going to go back to mark it for a false 3 hour ticket.

Jeff Bartley told us that 811 cannot decide what is or is not a rush ticket they can only go by what they are scripted to say.

Emergency tickets have the broadest range and you are taking a risk of liability with not locating but at the same time shouldn't have to go every time someone is not calling in tickets within the laws and requirements correctly.

Mock Line Strike is back on and scheduled for November 7th sign up online to register so they can get a count for the amount of food to have.

Tom Fahy w/ Frontier discussed some concerns he is having with a multitude of cut cables and the lack of concern in damaging lines that a company has and its costing money, time and customers and wanted to reach out to see what could be done or what his rights were.

Someone said that there should always be a cut ticket called in when a company damages a utility regardless of what utility. They should notify 811 and the utility owner.

Someone stated that if you know a locate ticket is off when you cut a line. You are held liable if you have knowledge of an unmarked facility and keep going.

Repeat offenders is there a training or can you communicate with someone and help them get some training?

There was mention and copies made of the Damage prevention Act & talk about the Damage Prevention Review Board – You can fill out the form and send it in with your evidence to be investigated they will

notify the offender and get their side of the story and their evidence. The Board will meet and determine if a fine of \$2500 per incident will be determined or if training is required for the offender.

If you know you are going to work on an area don't put in a ticket 60 days in advance & keep updating it. People will assume the work is done and not mark it.

Billy Miller asked that we send some volunteers to the Alamance, Orange, and Chatham meeting to get participation and growth for their UCC meetings.

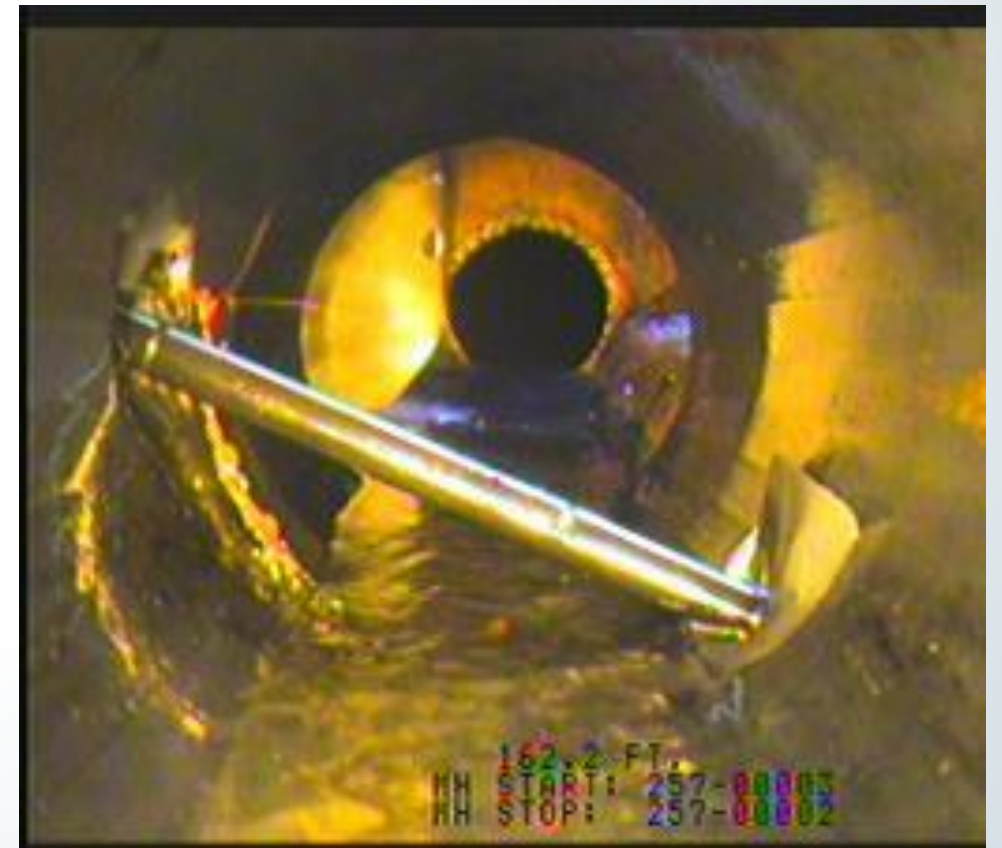
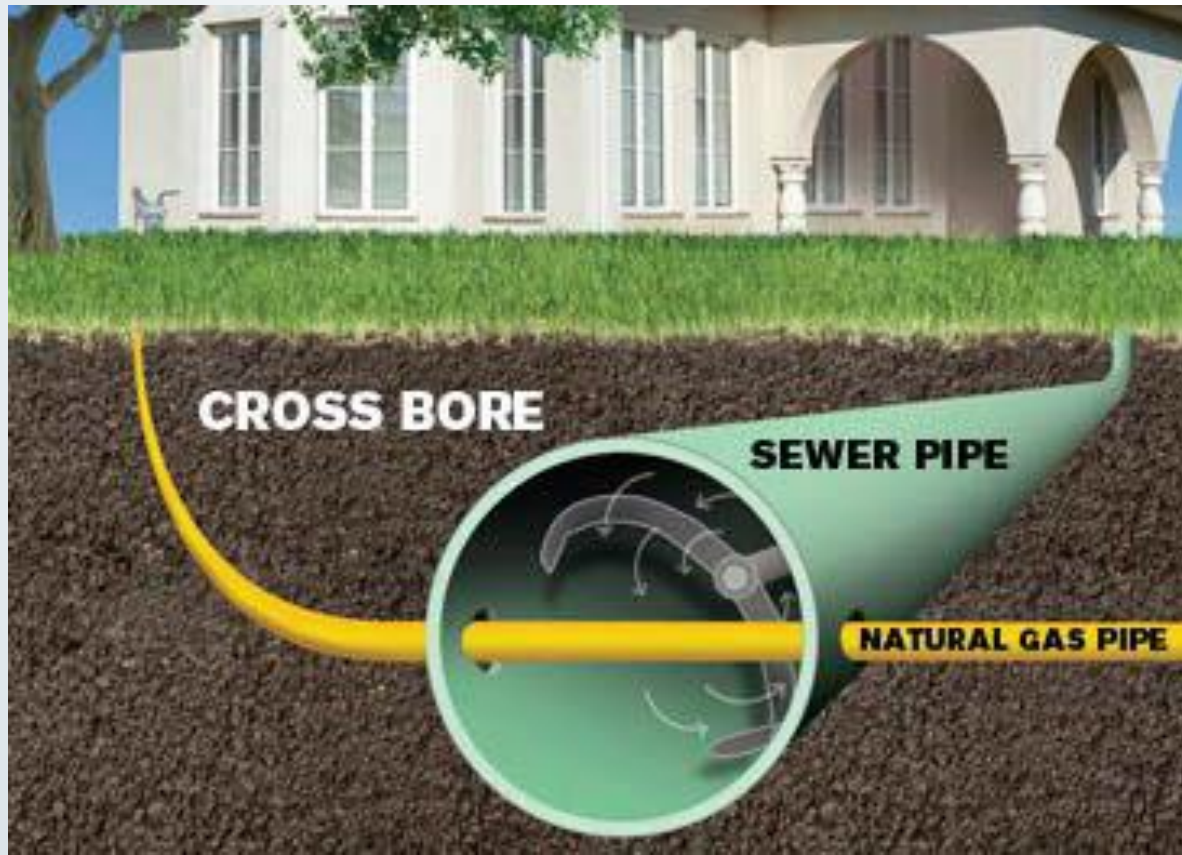

Stop all work immediately, Do not attempt to clear blockage with a mechanical device, Call operator immediately
