

Meeting Time: The meeting was called to order by Jeremy Mcfalls at 11:05 a.m. Introductions were made. Meeting was delayed with the anticipation of additional members arriving. Thought was that several of the people were unable to attend, as they might have been busy in dealing with the recent snow and ice.

Total Members Present: There were four members.

**Recent Damages:** There were no significant damages that this group were aware, within Rockingham County, since our last meeting.

#### **NC811 Presentation:**

Kevin Smith gave the NC811 presentation and reviewed the importance of contractors and locators working together. NC has the second largest call volume center in the country and we must all work together to lessen the burden of influx of locate tickets to make the system work at the most efficient level possible. Kevin reviewed the various steps that contractors can make to assist with the abundance of locate tickets requested.

#### **General Discussion:**

Reginald Quander with Southern Cross asked Kevin some questions pertaining to locate tickets. He asked a question concerning when a contractor requests a locate ticket and white lines the area and on the ticket it then states for them to locate the entire area. Kevin stated that the locate ticket is a binding legal document and if the ticket requests for a locate of the entire area, then that is what has to be done. Kevin reviewed the importance of white lining and to make certain that the white lining matches the locate request and description.

Kevin reviewed the three day working notice and then for contractors to call in a three-hour ticket. Kevin also reviewed what the law states about emergency locate tickets.
