Meeting Topics Discussed:

- Wesley Walton opened the meeting with a Level 1 Safety Minute. He went over who will call 911, who will do CPR, and who will use the AED unit. He also covered fire escape and inclement weather escape.
- Contractors are digging without any tickets. A lot of homeowners do not have locates. This
 gives us the opportunity to educate others. A suggestion may be to share the liability with the
 homeowner. Lowe's Home Improvement is doing their share by using logos and billboards
 across the state. Utility companies are putting up posters for customers to call 811 for
 underground digging. NC811 is the second largest company in the United States.
- Video (Working in the Sun): Seek shade whenever possible, put up a temporary shelter for
 working, do your work later in the day, move your work location, and wear long sleeve shirts
 and long pants. Wear sunglasses, hard hat, sunscreen with SPF protection, and check on
 coworkers. Start hydrating yourself the night before work. If you wait until you are thirsty, it
 will be too late.
- Ticket and Transmission Data: Tickets were down 2.9% from last year. Transmissions were up by 2.3% from last year with a total of 971,633 transmissions.
- County Ticket Volume: Guilford County had a total of 8,416 tickets this year. This was a decrease of 18.3% from last year. There were 399 average locates per day.
- County Ticket Distribution: Most of the tickets were in Greensboro, followed by High Point and then Summerfield.
