Meeting Topics Discussed:

- Excavator Testimonial (video): Company was digging a new line and encountered a pipeline.
 They called the irrigation company. There was no locate ticket. Cost of repair: \$900,000.
 Lesson Learned: Always plan your projects ahead of time. Always get your own "one call ticket." Each excavator needs a separate One Call Ticket. Make your online request at least three days ahead and call 811. This incident could have been an explosion.
- Everything has now been pigged in Greensboro. First of all, we go inside the pipe and clean it
 out. Then we take an instrument into the pipe to check the integrity of the inside of the pipe.
 We have lost tools inside the pipes and this in turn, damages the pipes. Tools are very
 expensive to buy. There are different types of pigs. Plate pigs have fins and are used to look for
 abnormalities. Brush pigs are used to clean out the inside of pipes. Geometry pigs (caliber pigs)
 are used to measure inside of pipe to make sure MFL will go through it.
- Locate Requests and Transmissions: For April, they had 156,103 locate tickets. This was an increase of 4.6% over 2016. Transmissions totaled 889,980 with an increase of 11.4% over 2016. If you are digging, you need your own locate ticket. You can also take photos of your locates.
- County Ticket Volume: Guilford County had a total of 8376 tickets for April. This was an increase of 9.2% from 2016. Average locates per day totaled 396.
- County Ticket Distribution: The majority of tickets were from Greensboro, followed by High Point and then Summerfield.
- Remote Ticket Entry: Total tickets were 156,103. Total tickets for April were 101,673 tickets.
- Incident Reports: Highest facility was Telecommunications, followed by Cable TV, Electric, and Natural Gas. Natural Gas was 14% of the total tickets. Most events were in Mecklenburg County, followed by Wake County.






Remote Ticket Entry




