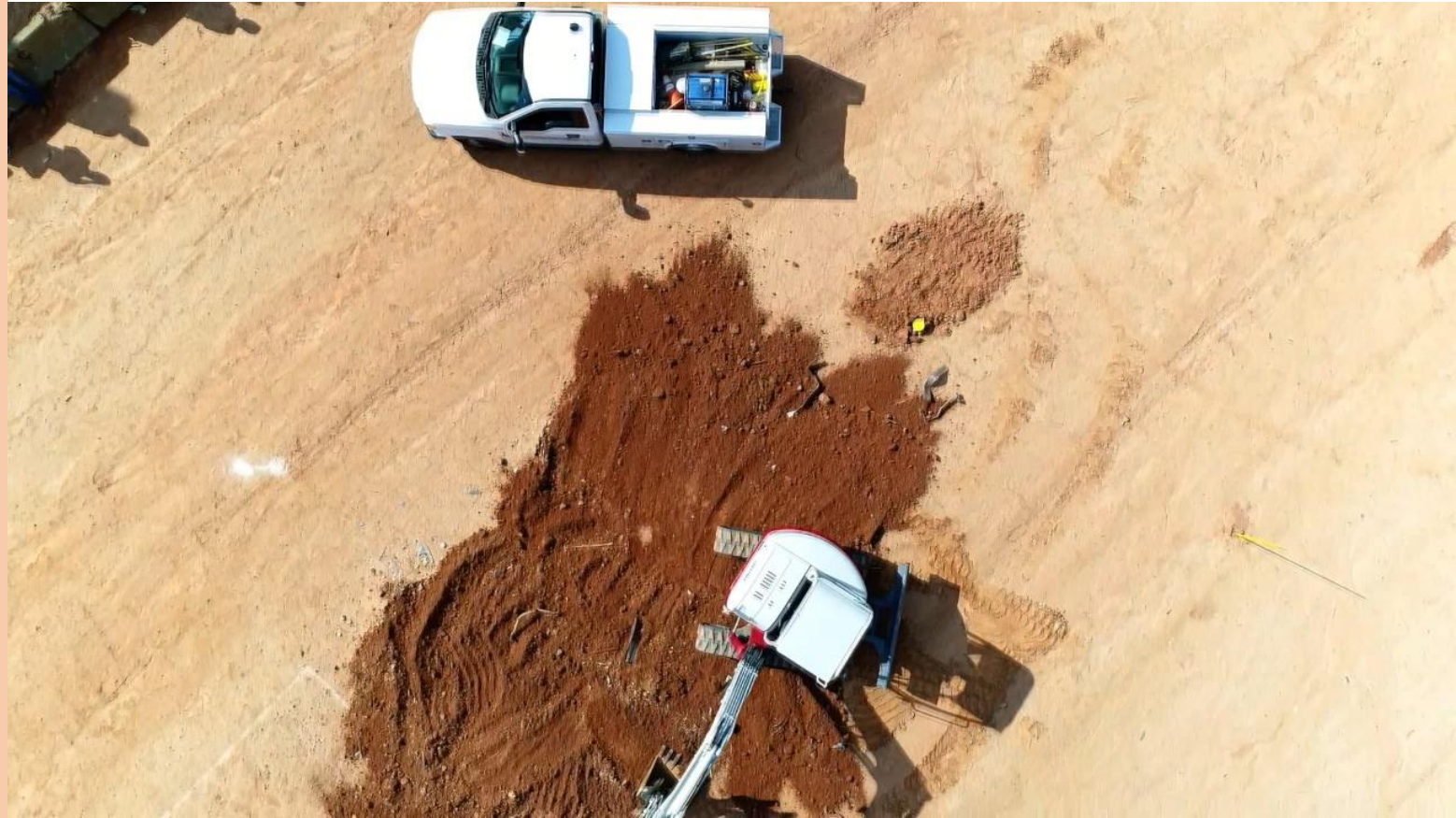

B. Review and Approval Of Previous Meeting’s Minutes

C. Old Business/New Business/Projects

1. NCDOT
 - DOT is still waiting on FEMA funds from the Hurricanes.
 - Projects are on hold for the time being.
2. PNG
 - Neon green paint is being used in PNG’s area to mark the gas lines, the best we can figure is someone is using this to freshen or “locate their own” without calling in a ticket.
3. Report – NC811 – Parrish Reddick
 - Parrish reported the numbers for the County.
 - There were two safety videos shared, the first was on school bus safety and the second working on electricity. The mock line strike is fast approaching (Oct 2nd) so sign up if you plan to attend. When calling in a locate request be as descriptive as possible “tell a story”.
4. Open floor for any new business
 - It was stated that locates/positive response are not being met, having to check the positive response and then request a 3 hour locate to get the locators out.
 - To help locators out please white line when you can and don’t overwhelm locators by calling thousands of feet for a job, only call them in a section at a time and let the locator keep ahead of you and be descriptive in your request.
