SREMC – Project on McArthur Rd in Harnett County near Broadway, Woodshire Subdivision extension in Anderson Creek area.

Discussion

Jeff Bartley presented the NC811 report. The Safe Digging Partner for January was Onslow Water and Sewer Authority. Locate requests for Harnett County were down 12.8 % from last year and in Johnston County they were up 24.8 %. Overall locate requests year to date were up 20.4% from 2016. Lillington had the most locate requests in Harnett County and Clayton had the most in Johnston County. 66.68% of all submittals were done by Remote Ticket Entry in January. Jeff reminded everyone of the Fire Station Marquee Challenge, post a brief reminder to call 811 on your marquee and you could win \$1000. Jeff also spoke about the NC811 app and demonstrated for the group some of its capabilities. The NC Underground Damage Prevention Review Board received 65 complaints, they have reviewed 54. Of these 33 were found to be violations, fines were recommended for 3 of these. 15 of the complaints did not have enough information and 6 were found to not be violations. The board will meet again on April 18th, you can attend these meetings but cannot participate. The SC/NC Joint UCC conference will be held this April in Myrtle Beach, SC. The next NCUCC meeting will be held in Raleigh on March 14th. The full NC811 report is attached to these minutes.

Andrew reminded everyone that the Annual **Contractor's Awareness/Damage Prevention Breakfast** is coming up on March 21 2017. Greg from GS Jenkins Plumbing mentioned that he had a locate ticket that had expired, he didn't realize that the ticket was expired and went to the location to work. There were marks on the ground so he began work but cut a line that was not marked. He was concerned that he had received a bill even though it was marked incorrectly. Jeff with NC811 explained that even if marks are present, once the ticket expires so do the marks and therefore the excavator is responsible for the damages.

Andrew adjourned the meeting and thanked everyone in attendance.





County Ticket Distribution








REMOTE TICKET ENTRY

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NC Underground Damage Prevention Review Board Update

- Some quick stats:
 - Of 65 total complaints received, 54 have been reviewed by the Board
 - 33 were found to be violations
 - Of those, 3 had fines recommended
 - 15 had either the wrong party identified or were missing critical information to make a determination
 - 6 were found to not be violations


