Projects:

SREMC – Distribution and Maintenance, subdivisions in Anderson Creek Area.

DOT – A lot of bridge replacements in Johnston County, widening NC42 from Buffalo Road to Glen Laurel about 5 miles. A lot of safety projects installing roundabouts.

Lee – project in Ammons area, project in Johnsonville on Hwy 87.

PNG –four bridge relocation projects in Harnett County along I95, Marshburn and Erwin Rd. Two transmission line replacements.

RLT – bores upcoming in the Erwin area.

Town of Clayton – charter school on Hwy 70 by Walmart.

Discussion

John Conner introduced himself, he will be replacing Jeff as of April 5th and he will be speaking at our breakfast in March.

Jeff Bartley presented the NC811 report. Locate requests for Harnett County were up 22.4% from last year and in Johnston County they were up 15.6%. Overall locate requests year to date were down 2.2% from 2016. Dunn had the most tickets in Harnett County and Clayton had the most in Johnston County. Jeff presented a video of the year 2017 in review. The joint NC/SC State UCC Conference is going to be held from May 2 – 4 at Harrah's Casino in Cherokee NC. The full NC811 report is attached to these minutes.

Kim with NCDOT asked that anyone who might have utilities in the area on NC42 from Buffalo Road to Glen Laurel to please get in touch with NCDOT. Jeff asked about the roundabouts and per Kim studies have shown that these are safer and work better to help traffic flow.

Jeff asked Linda with PNG if they had ever done joint trenching, per Linda it seems like a great idea but in reality it just didn't work out well for them.

Jeanelle with RLT said that she has seen an improvement with USIC over the last several months, she now has a contact that she can call and has had good results.
