Discussion

Kevin Smith presented the NC811 report. Kevin will be leaving our area so there is a NC811 Education Liaison position open, more information is on their website. April is safe digging month, there is a “toolkit” for safe digging available on the NC811 website. Locate requests for Harnett County were up 1.3% from last year and in Johnston County they were up 17.1%. Overall locate requests year to date were up 17.8%. Locator Safety Awareness Week is 4/22/19-4/27/19. Kevin asked that we share the 811 message on our company website if possible. Home Depot and Lowe’s have been sharing the 811 message through tree wraps, plants and shovels. NC811 recognized Max Chapman as a Damage Prevention Ambassador at the Burke Caldwell Utility Coordinating Committee Meeting in March. There will be a Mock Line Strike in Concord on October 2, 2019 and there will be free locator training on October 1st and 2nd. CenturyLink has new locators, Graycliff and Direct SAT (Utilitech) however the contact number on the tickets is for a CenturyLink contact. The full NC811 presentation is attached to these minutes.

Ann with NC811 reminded everyone that you can call a locate in up to 12 days ahead of time and this would give the locators more time to complete your locate. Ann also mentioned that they are seeing a rise in 3 hour tickets.

David Akers with SREMC asked if you could change the name on a ticket to your contractor’s name if you decide to let them do the work. Per Ann, you cannot change the name but you can add the Contractor to the ticket, you will still be liable for any damages. David also asked if the locate companies were hiring more locators, according to Kevin they are redistributing there current locator to busier areas.

Kevin adjourned the meeting and thanked everyone in attendance.

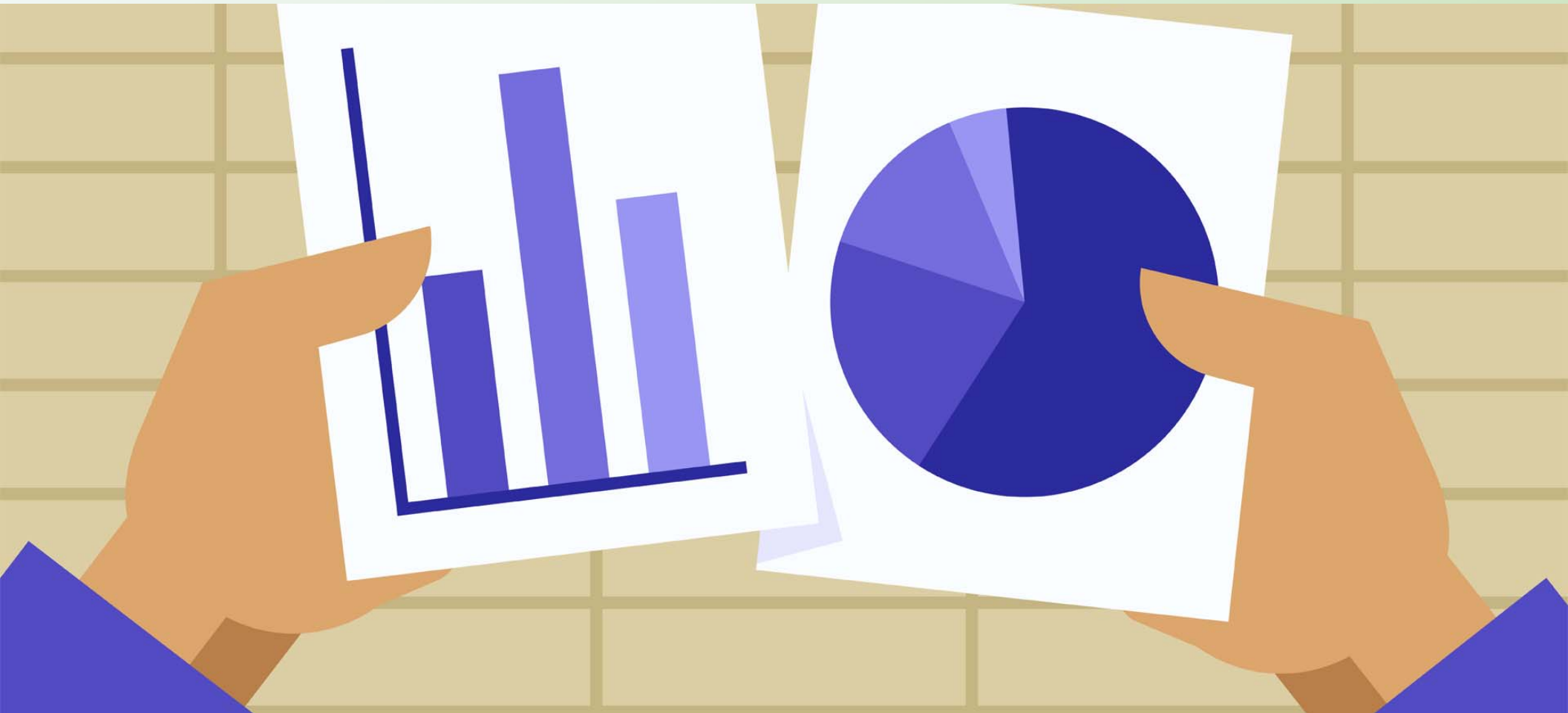

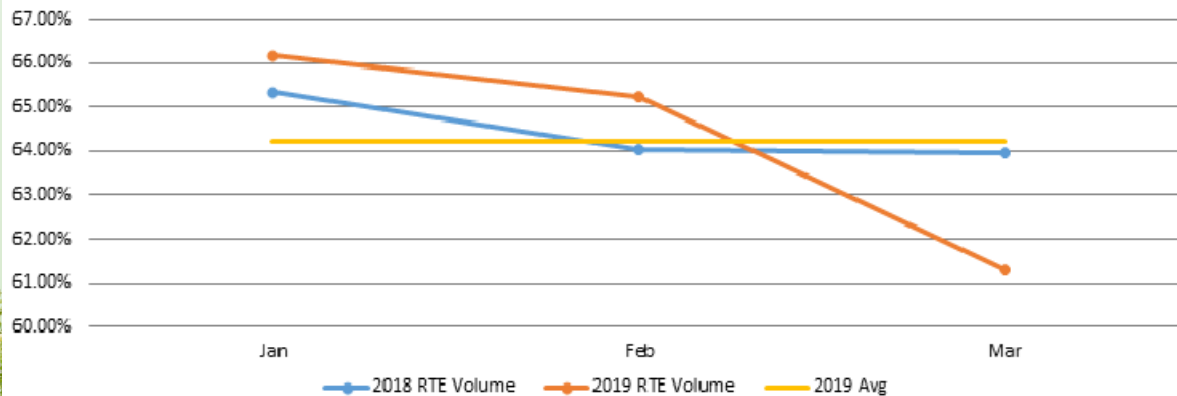


RTE Volume 2019 vs 2018
