





If the diameter or width of the facility is greater than four inches, the dimension of the facility shall be indicated at least every 50 feet in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition. An operator who operates multiple facilities in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition shall locate each facility.

The operator's identity, marked as provided in subdivision (1) of this subsection, in the area where the proposed excavation or demolition is to occur. At a minimum, the operator's identity shall be marked at the beginning point, at intervals of 200 linear feet, and at the end point of the proposed excavation or demolition.

Projects:

SREMC – Subdivisions in Anderson Creek area, pole change outs in Johnston County and pole attachment transfers.

PNG – 8 inch main in Angier in Harnett County, road widening NCDOT projects, 8 inch line on Hwy 42, new mains for Hampton Inn in Smithfield. Upcoming project: new transmission line in Johnston County the end of 2020.

Parrish Reddick with NC811 reminded everyone of the UCC Monthly Damage and Project Report sheet that he has given out, you can get input from others at your organizations and have this filled out before coming to the meetings to provide a more accurate record of projects. October is Tackling Hunger Month, Parrish showed a number of ways that you can help to fight hunger in your communities. The NC811 presentation showed that overall locate tickets were up 13.9% from last year. Harnett County had a .5% increase in locates and Johnston County had a 16.9% increase. Parrish reminded everyone of the law changes that went into effect on October 1, 2019 through House Bill 872, the NC811 website and the NC811 app have information on these changes. The entire NC811 presentation will be attached to these minutes.
