Discussion

John Conner presented the NC811 report. April is Safe Digging Month; the toolkit and banners are available by request. Locate requests for Harnett County were up 45.5% from last year and in Johnston County they were up 28.8%. Lillington had the most tickets in Harnett County and Clayton had the most in Johnston County. John distributed "Your guide to Safe Digging" pamphlets and asked us to share them with others that we come in contact with. He also discussed the difference in a 3 hour ticket and a destroyed marks ticket and why it is important to use the correct one. John mentioned the "Share 811" campaign and how we can all help share the message. There is an area on the NC811 website where you can issue a complaint for the Damage Prevention Review Board. The full NC811 report is attached to these minutes.

Tom with the Town of Clayton mentioned how important it is to build relationships between the locators and the utilities/contractors. He also mentioned that the more specific you can be in your description on locates the more locates can be done in a day. Vague locate descriptions take a lot of time because you are locating large areas that are not in the scope of the project. White paint or white flags are also very helpful so the locator will know exactly where you plan to dig. It was also discussed that if you know it is going to rain the next day, you may want to wait to call in the ticket so you won't have to call in a destroyed marks ticket later.

Andrew reminded everyone that the Annual Contractor's Awareness/Damage Prevention Breakfast is coming up on March 20th. If you can help in any way, please contact Kacey at 910-230-2960. Destroyed Marks & 3 Hour Tickets

When to properly use each

A series of several parallel white lines of varying lengths and thicknesses, slanted diagonally from the bottom-left towards the top-right, located in the lower right quadrant of the slide.

DESTROYED MARKS

If locate marks have been destroyed, the excavator must contact NC811 to issue a Destroyed Marks ticket requesting a remark of the area from the original ticket.

A Destroyed Marks ticket does not extend the life of ticket; it will expire the same day as the original locate request. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in case of destroyed marks.

3 HOUR TICKET

If an operator fails to respond to the positive response system, the excavator may proceed if there are no visible indications of a facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, such as a pole, marker, pedestal, meter, or valve. However, if the excavator is aware of or observes indications of an unmarked facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, the excavator shall not begin excavation or demolition until an additional call is made to the Notification Center detailing the facility and an arrangement is made for the facility to be marked by the operator within three hours from the time the additional call is received by the Notification Center. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in the case of destroyed marks.
