Discussion

Jeff Bartley presented the NC811 report. He said that NC811 will be sending out a survey for ideas on how to improve the UCC meetings; he asked that we take a minute and fill these out. Locate requests for Harnett County were up 21.6% from last year and in Johnston County they were up 15.2%. Overall locate requests year to date were up .8% from 2016. Lillington had the most locate requests in Harnett County and Clayton had the most in Johnston County. Jeff also presented a video, "Matt's Safety Story", this was a lineman from Appalachian Power who had a close call with children playing around and under the truck. He spoke about how easy it would have been to not notice they were there and what a tragedy it could have been. Jeff talked about the Circle Check and about not just looking around the truck but also looking under the truck. He also mentioned that he witnessed a Duke Energy truck pulling into a parking lot and the passenger guiding the driver when backing, per Linda with PNG Duke is implementing new levels of safety. David with SREMC said that they also do the Circle Check and have installed backup cameras on all vehicles. Per Jeff, Brunswick Water & Sewer is the Safe Digging Partner for this month. The Mock Line Strike has been rescheduled for November 7, 2017. Last but not least, Jeff Bartley will be retiring in April of 2018 and will be truly missed. The full NC811 report is attached to these minutes.

Andrew adjourned the meeting and thanked everyone in attendance.
