#### **Projects:**

**SREMC** –reconductoring project almost done in Johnston County on Morgan Rd in Benson.

**PNG** – Johnston – Hwy 42 project, relocate some 8 inch from Buffalo Rd. to Glen Laurel Rd.

**NCDOT** – Replacing 2 bridges, Leaflet Church Rd. & Elliott Bridge Rd. at Overhills.

**Calyx – NCDOT –** Replacing/expanding 5 bridges on I95 between Benson and I295, let date is in 2019.

#### Discussion

Kevin Smith presented the NC811 report. June is National Safety Month and Kevin reminded everyone to stay hydrated especially before going out in the sun. Water, gatorade, milk and juice are fine but you should avoid coffee, alcohol, soda and energy drinks. He also said to make sure you cover up and protect your skin from the sun. Another good idea is to time it right, 11 AM to 4 PM are the hottest hours of the day, and take breaks. Year to date locate requests were up 3.1%. Locate requests for Harnett County were up 2.6% from last year and in Johnston County they were up 20.8%. Lillington had the most tickets in Harnett County and Clayton had the most in Johnston County. The Damage Review Board will be meeting on July 17th and October 16th in Raleigh. The State NCUCC meeting is going to be July 10th in Hickory. The NC811 Board Meeting will be held July 20th in Lake Lure, NC. National 811 Day is coming up on August 11th. The full NC811 report is attached to these minutes.

Ryan Zakary with Branz Safety was in attendance and told us about his company. They do Work Zone Safety presentations to include traffic control, working inside a work zone and automatic flagging devices. They also provide training and safety equipment. He shared a lot of valuable safety information and we appreciated him speaking with us.

Rick Bounds with Calyx Engineers asked how we could increase attendance at our meetings, he stressed that with all the upcoming NCDOT projects it is very important for all utilities to be in attendance.

Kevin adjourned the meeting and thanked everyone in attendance.



# Safety Tips for working outdoors this summer



### **DRINK UP**

Thirsty or not, drink plenty of water – a cup every 15 to 20 minutes. Avoid caffeine or alcohol which can dehydrate you.

### **ACCLIMATIZE**

It takes time to adjust to working in heat. Work with your supervisor to gradually increase your work load and heat exposure.



# Safety Tips for working outdoors this summer



### **COVER UP AND PROTECT**

Wear light, loose-fitting clothing, UV rated sunglasses, and a wide-brim hat. Apply sunscreen with a Sun Protection Factor (SPF) of at least 30 and UVA / UVB protection. Reapply every 2 hours and after sweating.

### **SHIELD FROM SUN**

Set up shade structures or use umbrellas, buildings, or trees to shield you from the rays of the sun. You can get sunburn on a cloudy day.



# Safety Tips for working outdoors this summer



### **TIME IT RIGHT**

Try and avoid the sun and strenuous tasks between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. when the sun's rays are strongest.

### **COOL OFF**

Take breaks to rest and cool off in the shade or in air-conditioned buildings or vehicles. Don't over-exert yourself.
