#### **Projects:**

**SREMC** – Subdivisions and regular maintenance.

**PNG** –Transmission project in Harnett County and Distribution projects on Susan Tart Rd, Spring Branch Rd, and Yam St.

**PSC** – Project on Cleveland School Rd. for new subdivision, River Oaks Subdivision on Hwy 42, project at Keith Hills coming up in Harnett County, Flowers Plantation, replacement project in Selma on Ricks Road and many more project in Johnston County. (Contractor for PNG)

#### Discussion

Jeff Bartley presented the NC811 report. Locate requests for Harnett County were up 20.4% from last year and in Johnston County they were up 14.3%. Overall locate requests year to date were down 1.1% from 2016. Lillington had the most locate requests in Harnett County and Clayton had the most in Johnston County. Jeff showed a video and spoke about the importance of being careful when you have a clogged pipe. You should not assume it is tree roots, you should get a professional to make sure it is not a utility line like natural gas. Jeff spoke and showed a video about the difference between a Destroyed Marks ticket and a 3 Hour ticket. The Destroyed Marks ticket expires at the same time that the original locate request expires. The 3 Hour ticket should not be used if the marks are destroyed, this ticket is for the excavator in the event, that upon arrival at the site, he/she sees evidence of a utility that is not marked. Jeff said that according to USIC, when they receive a 3 Hour ticket they review their pictures from the original request and if the marks were there they do not respond to the 3 Hour ticket. There is a job opportunity at NC811, Jeff will be retiring in April 2018. The full NC811 report is attached to these minutes.

Morgan with PRG said in Harnett County a utility is installing water line up Hwy 421 toward Sanford and they are tearing up a lot of Spectrum lines, the locating is hit and miss.

There was some discussion concerning Aqua NC responding to locates. They are not responding to the locate requests and they are not responding to calls to their office.

After some questions about facilities not being marked and the response being No Conflict, Jeff reminded everyone that if you see evidence of a facility you need to call in a 3 Hour ticket even if the response was No Conflict.

Andrew adjourned the meeting and thanked everyone in attendance.




