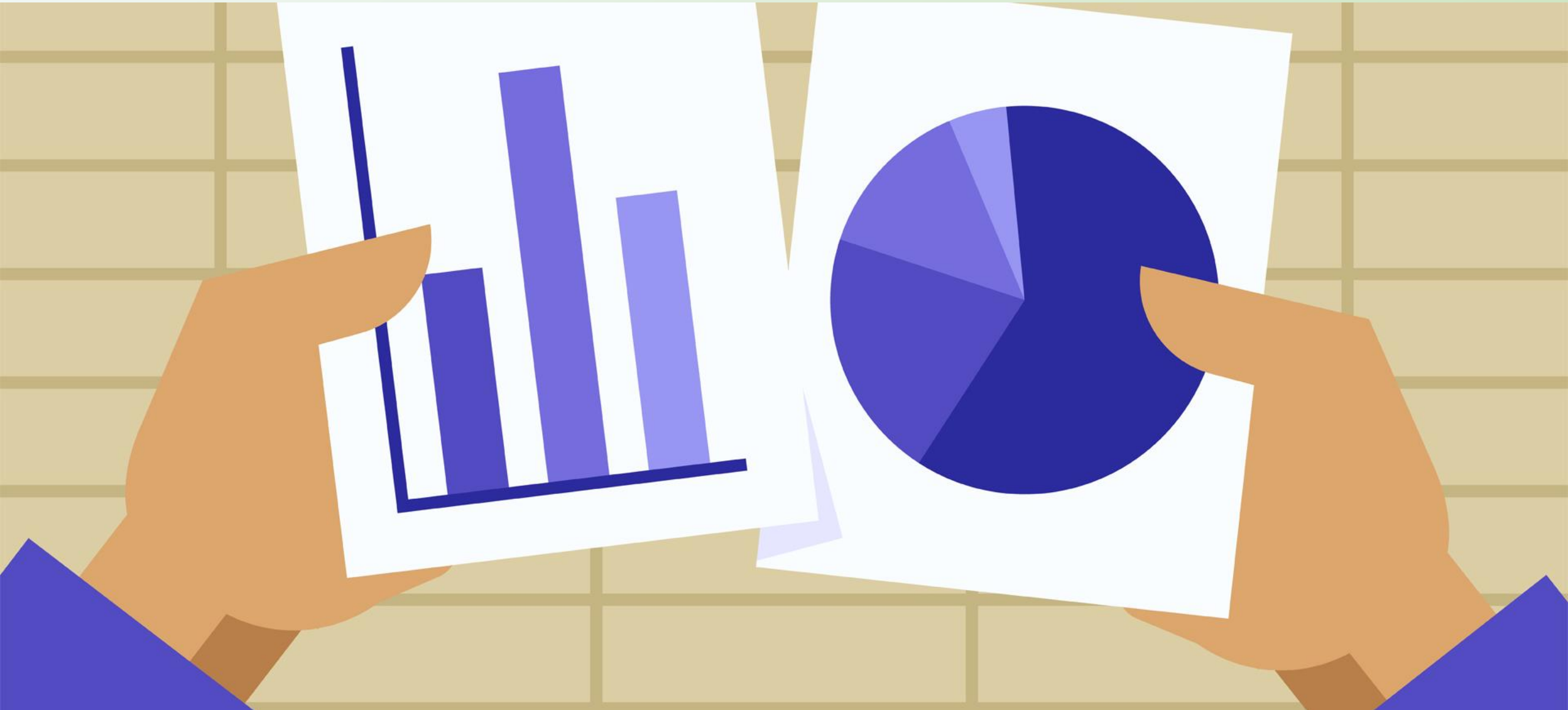

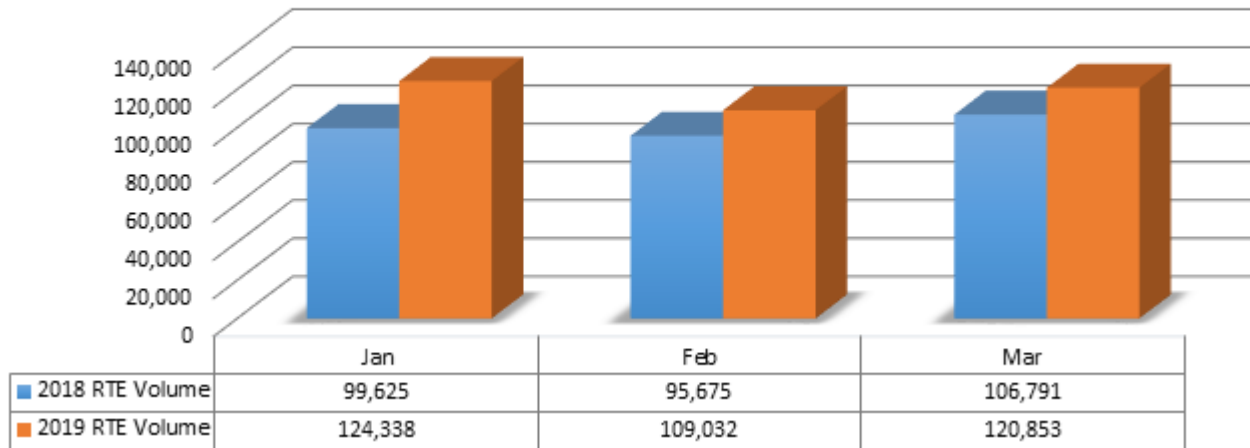
County Ticket Distribution

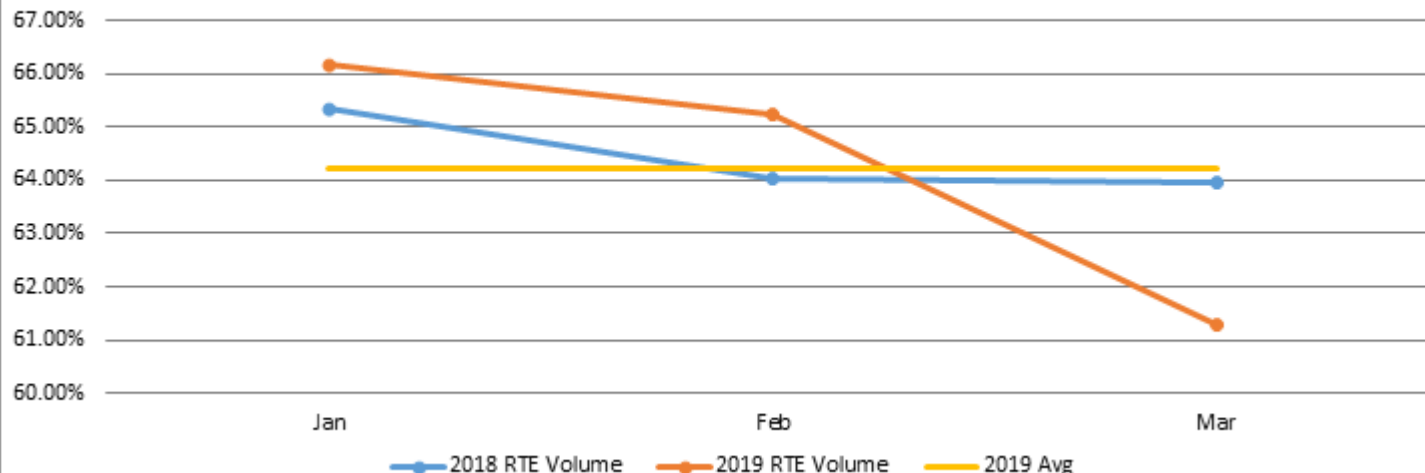
