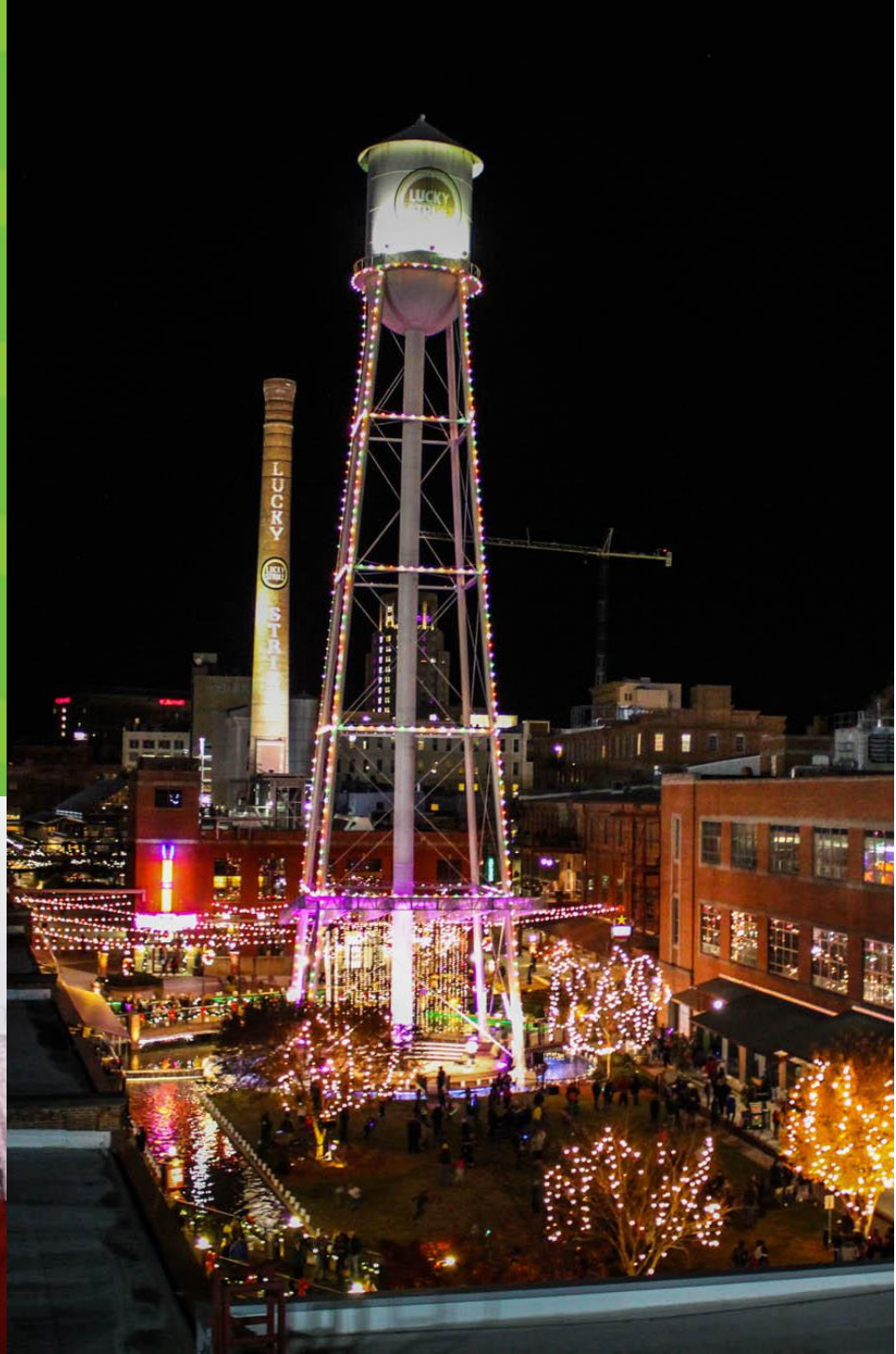

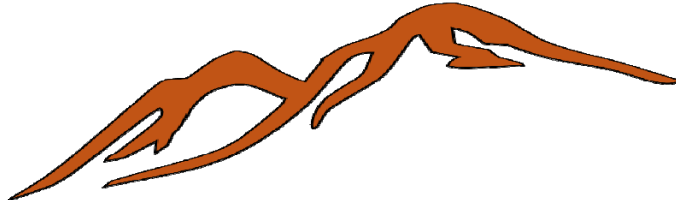

- Brian Morehouse went over housekeeping and emergency evacuation.

Introductions

- Brian Morehouse started introductions, and then went around the room.
- Safety Share presented by: Brian Morehouse
- Topic – Happy Holidays to all !!! Ways to be safe over the Holidays!!!

Old Business

- Any Changes to last month’s minutes? Mentioned to all that we have had as many as 20 in attendance, Very good for this one county. Reminder that NC811 is here for any education needed.
- New Excavation Guideline Manuals will be out early part of 2020. NEW look,

Officer Reports

Chair- The UCC group talked about officers for 2020. It was addressed to keep the Officers as they are at this time. The group discussed what they would like to do in 2020 as far as meeting at a different place. We scheduled this restaurant for February 2020 and the group will make a decision at that time on their plans for the remainder of the year.

New Business

- **NC 811 / One Call** presentation was given by: This group has grown over the 2019 year, everyone was “Thanked” for their hard work and a safe year. Many that attend have become Safe Digging Partners. Brian Morehouse talked to the group on ways to encourage others to attend the meetings and help get the 811 message out to all.

**Open Discussion December 2020 Presentation has been included in this program to be viewed.
Reports**

- A. **NC 811 / One Call** –Brian Morehouse-Western Region Liaison had everyone introduce themselves and tell what organization they were with. NC811 gave the rundown on the number for YTD and for the Month of November 2019 compared to November 2018. The group was informed of the upcoming events for NC811.
- B. **Brian Morehouse addressed the group about being safe over the Holiday season.** *Deer are all over the place, always drive with care and beware of the deer on the side of the road. Night driving be very cautious. Went over safety around the house when decorating. Make sure not to plug in too many electrical items in one receptacle Fire Hazards and the danger of what can happen when you do this.*
- C. **NC811 talked with the group about the new law changes, 1,320 ft- ¼ of a mile, (5) addresses and tickets that can be called in for one piece of property that needs to be marked**
- D. **Group was informed about the holiday schedule, please be aware of what days NC811 will be closed for business, and what is and isn't part of the (3) Business Day process.**
- E. **Brian Morehouse discussed with the group how the LRPC works and what the group is trying to accomplish.**
- F. *NC811 talked to the group about the Liaison Meeting that took place in Asheville back in November. Talked with the group about the difference in other 811 organizations, with their laws and etc..*
- G. **N.C.D.O.T –**
- H. **Dominion Energy – NO major damages to report in the area. General work continues as given the last few months. Mention that the rebranding process continues and will be going on in this area thru February 2020. A Contractor is going throughout the area changing the markers and putting updated information on them along with the new Dominion Energy logo. Removing the old PSNC information. T3 Line Survey in Canton will be completed in January 2020.**
- I. **USIC – NA**
- J. **Town of Clyde- Town of Waynesville-** (2) new 20,000 galleon tanks are going on line by the end of 2019, this will continue on into 2020. (2) new set of apartments are going up within the area. TOW has many of their lines within the area. Chestnut Hall Project continues and will go well into 2020. Reported that they do have a number of DOT projects within the area that they are working on and no issues at this time to report. Has reported that they have not had no major damages to report since the last meeting in October 2019. TOW stated that work continues on West Main with that project that started over the last month. Has stated that there are plans in the review states with expectations of new work being release in the early part of 2020
- K. **NO major reports of locating issues within the area. The group agreed that things have been going rather well.**
