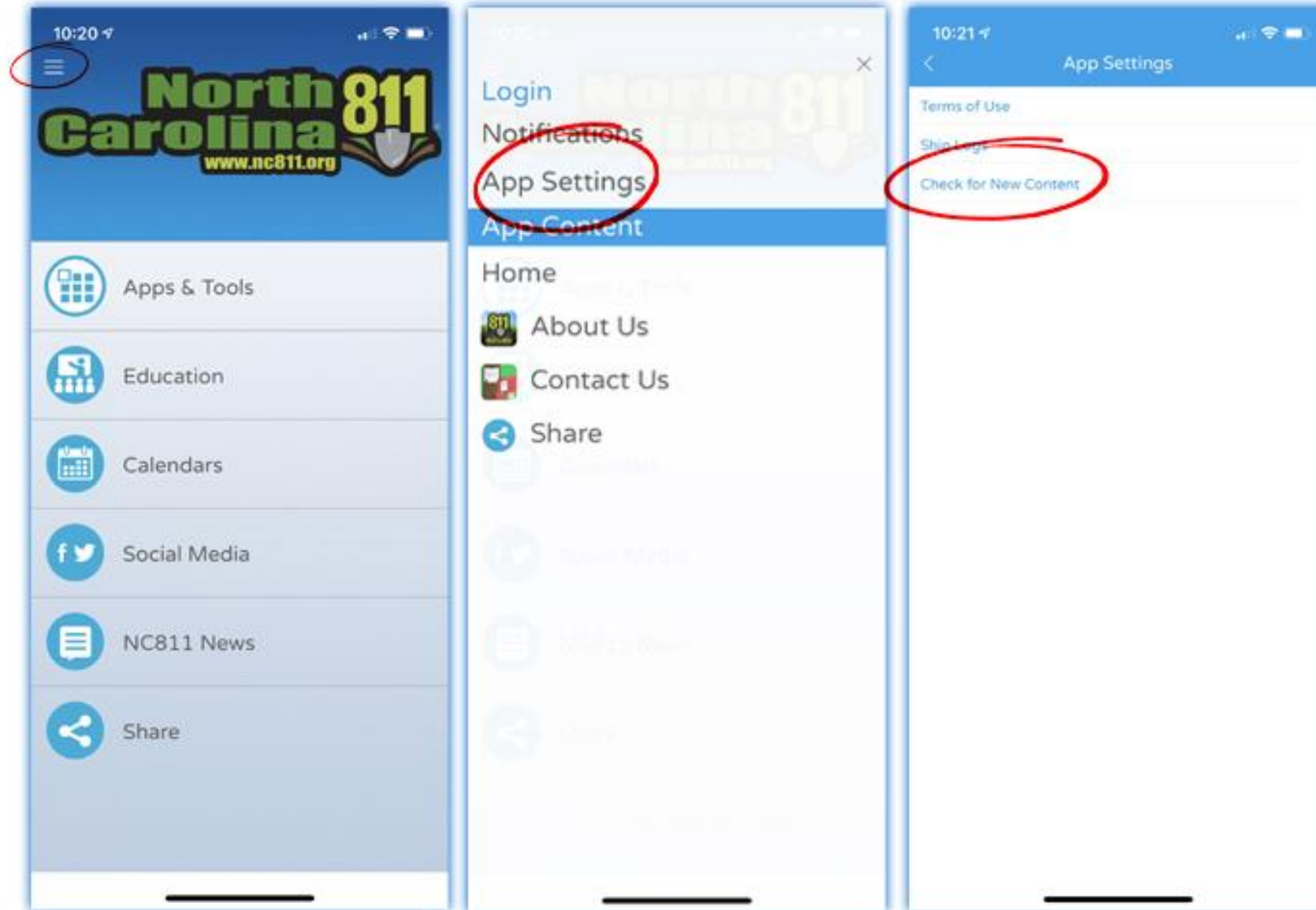

Introduction around the room with all in attendance

The group voted on having all (6) meetings at this location in 2019

Old Business—Reviewed with the group the difference between a (3) Hour Ticket and a Destroyed Marks Ticket. An when calling in a ticket and all utilities hasn't cleared, to make sure to call in a (3) Hour ticket before doing any type of digging.

New Business- Went over how to download the NEW 811 App and be able to search tickets on it from new tickets to near tickets. Encouraged all to use this app.

Spoke to the group about everyone becoming a Safe Digging Partner. To sign up and get the 811 stickers.

New Projects—

NCDOT- Hwy 110 Project continues; Waynesville project is coming along. North Main and Rust Ave work continues. Brown Hall Road Bridge replacement has been released for completion at the end of 2019, and Brown Hollow Road Bridge replacement in 2019

The Town of Waynesville- Maintenance work continues, Emergency repairs, no new subdivisions have been released

PSNC- The Short Rd and Hospital line is having an extension, 2" Main Line to E Street. Directional Boring on east side, going under sidewalk in that area. Canton-110 relocation of line for NCDOT Project, Job awarded for relocation of line at new Roundabout. New Gas main being installed to new Publix Store and also to the new strip mall that will house Pizza Hut there in Waynesville.

Brian Morehouse, Western Region Education Liaison NC 811, gave this month's presentation. Opening up the program and talking about the many uses of the NEW 811 App. How to download it or to update their existing APP. Spoke to the group about the many ways that you can use this App in your everyday work. Answered questions the group had about the APP and encouraged them to use it.

As we can see across the region (3) hour tickets are up, and spoke with the group on why this maybe.
