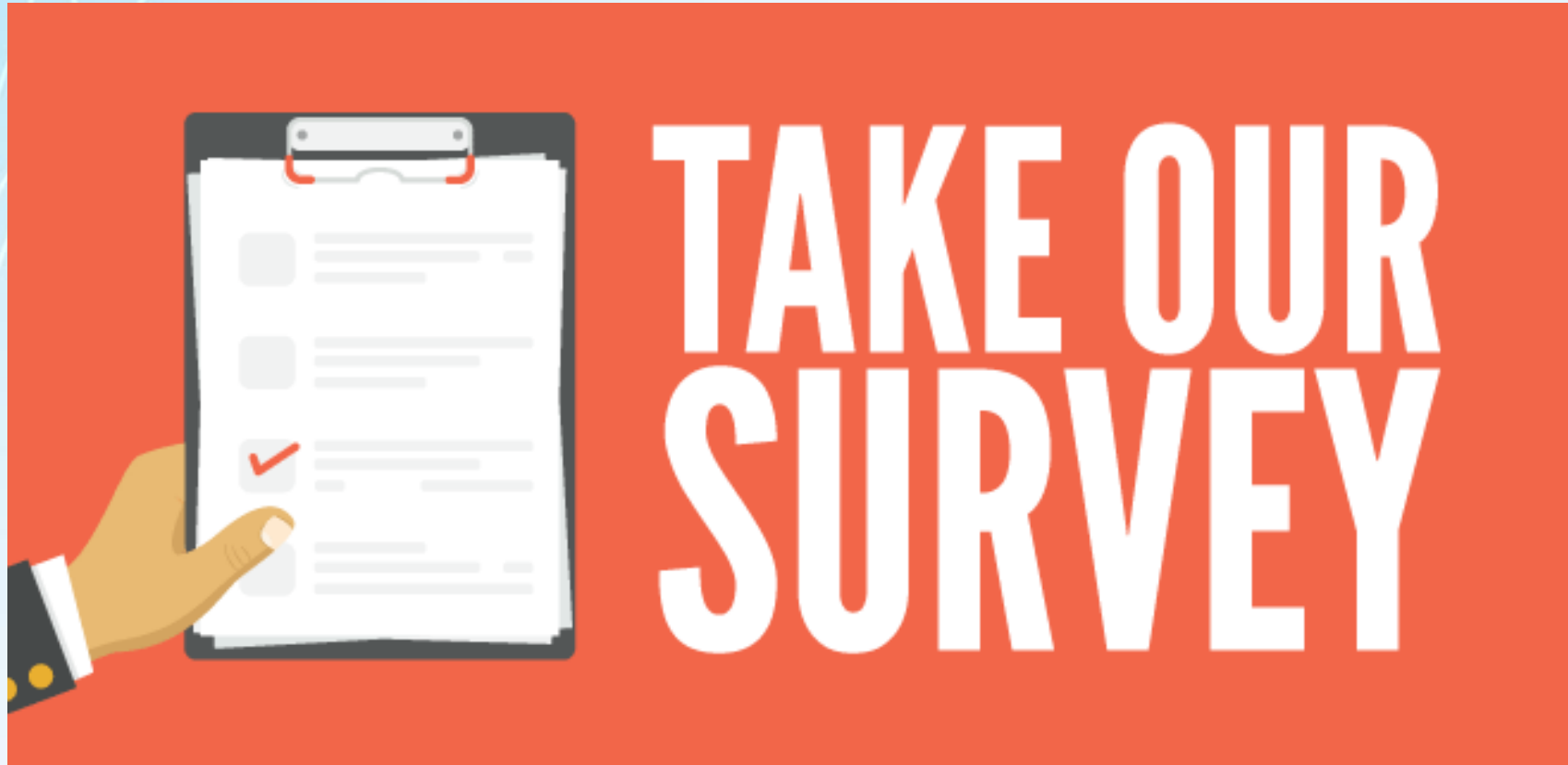

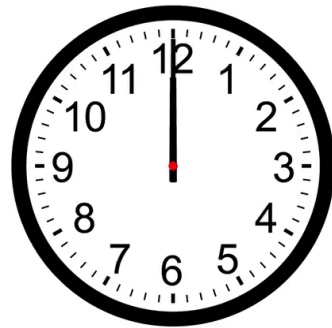
3 Hour Notice vs Destroyed Marks

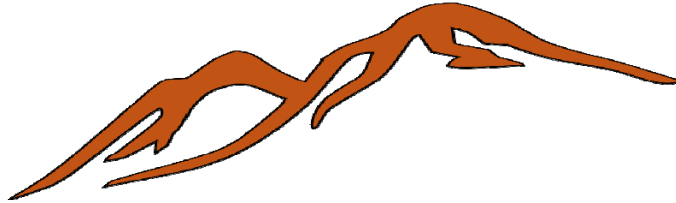

- NC 811 / One Call presentation was given by: **Brian Morehouse-Western Region Education Liaison gave the June 2019 Presentation for High Point. Went over the Top 10 Work Place Violations.
