





New Business

• NC 811 / One Call presentation was given by: <u>Brian Morehouse went over</u> what is 811? Gave update on the process and expectations of 811. From calling a ticket in to sending out the Positive Response to the caller.

Open Discussion Talked about issues within the area with contractors not calling in locates and then reaching out to the locators within the area. Or calling in locates (3) Hour, before ever going out to the site to make sure it has been marked as needed. Contractors state that they are from other areas and that they aren't even sure if it has been marked, but they call to just to cover themselves.

Reports

- A. NC 811 / One Call Brian provided us with the monthly 811 update. Also Brian talked to us about 811 having 811 come to your office and do an 811 Safety Presentation. Brian Morehouse went over the October 2019 presentation giving the totals for YTD and Monthly number for Tickets called in, average locates per day and (3) hour tickets. (This is included as a PDF on the UCC website) Went over the 2019 Call-Ins with all in attendance. Giving final numbers. 811 took in over 2.2. million tickets for the entire year with over 12 Million Transmissions. Very busy year for all. Reviewed with the group the (3) Hour tickets and we looked over how that number for the month of December has come down in majority of the areas. Brian Morehouse went over the need to keep growing our UCC. Handed out cards for all to take and hand out to their contractors inviting them to the UCC meeting with times/dates. It was also addressed how the UCC will be stepping up on running their UCC, each UCC needs to have a Chairman, Co-Chairman, Secretary. It was mentioned that everyone could take the time to take notes for each meeting. Brian Morehouse has been doing this for the UCC. Everyone asked if we could just pass around a paper for all to put long projects down on. That was done. Still need a Secretary to take minutes of the meeting. Issues were brought up by Dominion Energy how some are not getting their emails as they use too. They have had email address changes.
- B. N.C.D.O.T Bridge work continues throughout the area; it was reported that certain projects may be put on hold due to the budget. Small bridge work will continue with general maintenance and culvert repairs still on schedule. I-26 widening is the biggest project on record for them in this area.
- C. Dominion Energy <u>NO major damages to report in the area. Reported that Hydromax is installing signs at all stations and above ground facilities. DENC employees will be with contractors on site while work is being performed. General Maintenance work is taking place in the area.</u>
- D. USIC Reports that they have hired within the area and have a good staff.
