

Dominion Energy- Locates are up and staying really busy with keeping up with the workload coming in. Small project around the area taking place at this time but nothing major to report. Have (3) subdivisions that new NG lines are being installed in.

Comporium- New installation and cable replacement taking place and looks to be busy throughout 2019

NCDOT- Work continues to be heavy with road widening, shoulder work being done throughout the area. (4) Bridge projects have been turned over in April.
