

Meeting started at 12:44 PM

Brian Morehouse, Western Region Education Liaison, gave the March 2019 Presentation.

Gave the overall stats for this area for the Month of February 2019 compared to the Month of February 2018, gave the YTD totals. A short video was shown to the group in regards to calling 8111 Before You Dig!! The video showed an incident that involved a gas company and what can happen when someone doesn't Call 811 Before You Dig!!!

Brian Morehouse told the group that there are openings throughout the year if anyone is interested in having 811 come in and speak to their organization about 811, when, why and how to contact 811. Also, went over the new 811 app, encourage all to download the app. Went over with the group on how to navigate the app and showing them how to get to the Damage Prevention portion of the app.

Brian Morehouse went over with the group that if they have any issues to make sure to reach out to him with those issues and please don't wait to the meeting to address them. Reason-he doesn't want to have them waiting two or three weeks to get an issues resolved, he would like to jump on it ASAP

NCDOT- Shoulder work continues; bridge work is keeping them rather busy thru August

USIC- Very busy with locates, has seen a big jump in work in 2019, keeping up, have had issues with people not giving enough information on tickets. Report of one company abusing the (3) hr ticket. Stated that they will call in three-hour ticket without even going out on site and making sure the area is marker. Brian Morehouse is looking into this issue.

PSNC- Large project in Henderson, states that they have been also very busy with locates since the beginning of the year. Large project near Airport Rd

Hendersonville Water- Very busy at this time with pipe replacements throughout the county and retirements. Locators stated that they are staying rather busy with locates coming in but are staying up with the work.

Ansco- Stated that the have plenty of work in the area with cable replacement in the Henderson, Polk, Trans area.

Duke Energy- Reported they see a big growth in work for 2019. Three Phase work being done. No report of work around the area,

Brian Morehouse will be looking into locate issues reported to him on how locates are called in with smaller companies.
