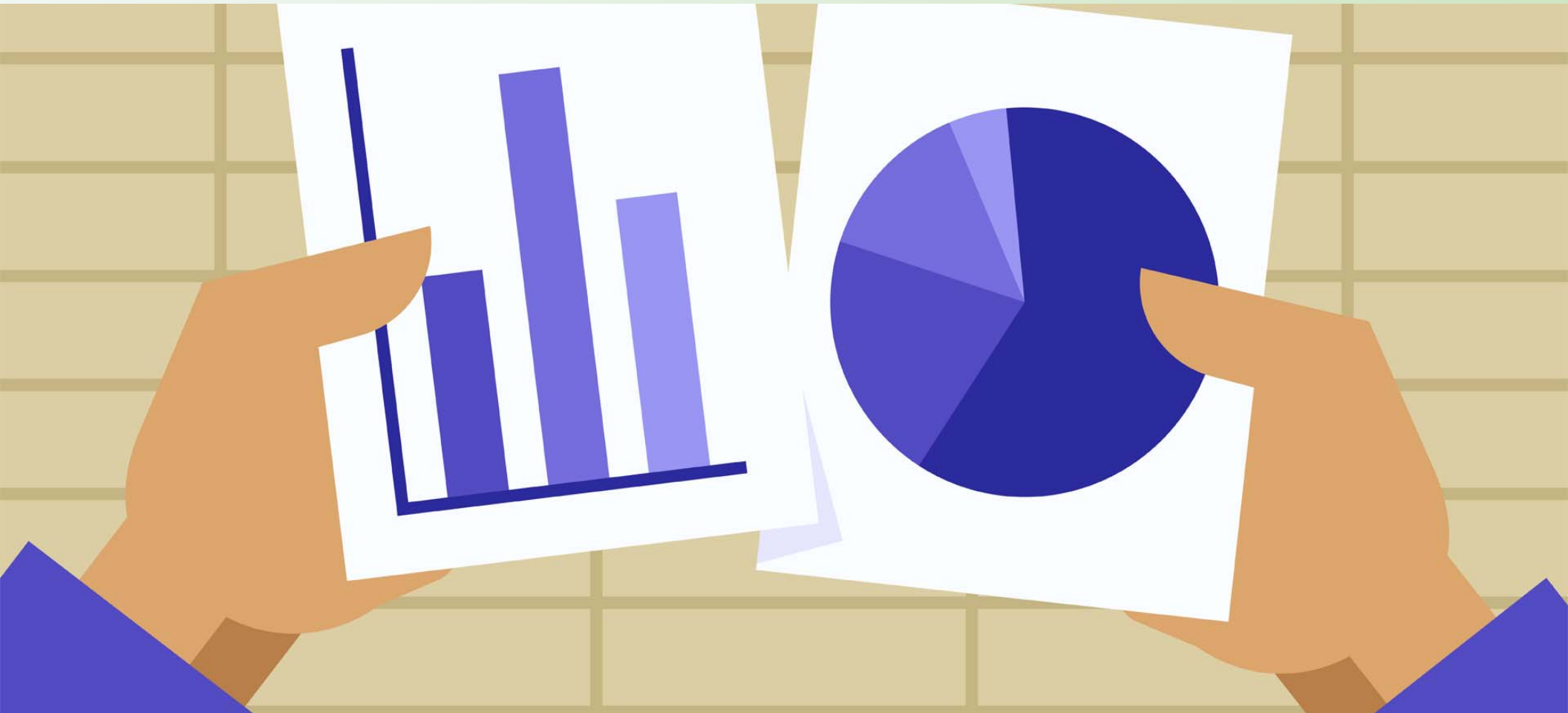

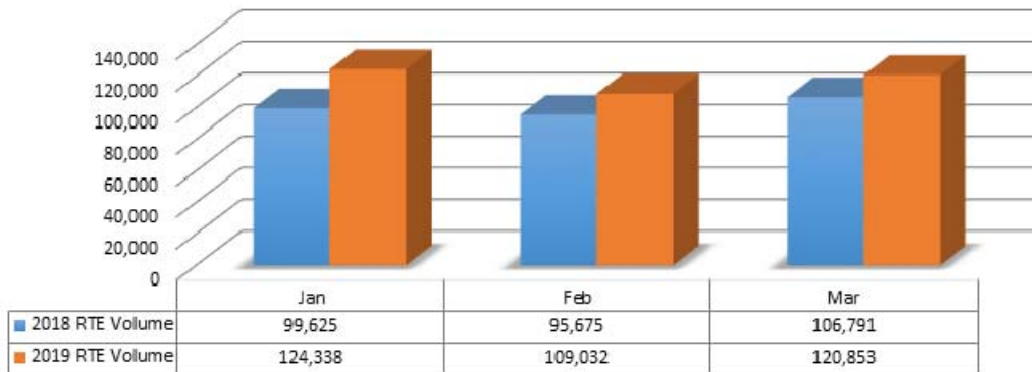

Remote Ticket Entry

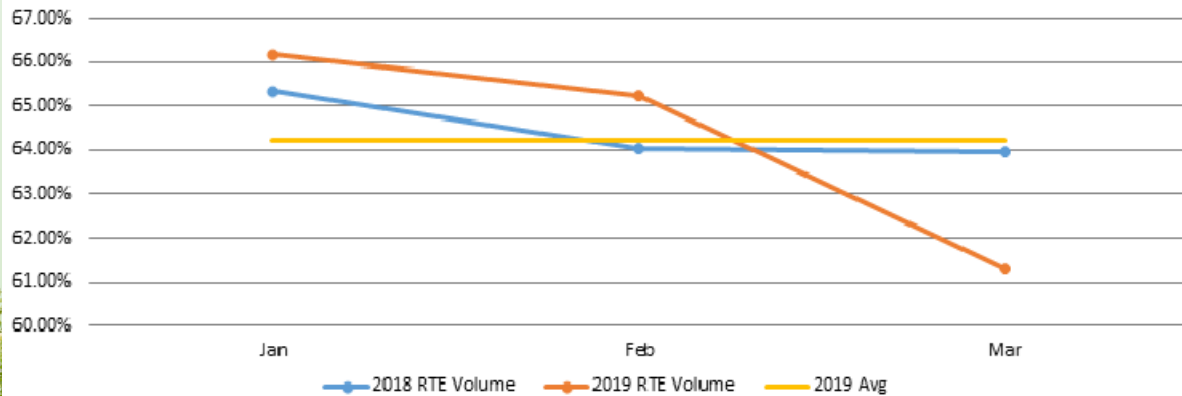


RTE Volume 2019 vs 2018
