Self-introductions around the room.

PSNC- Completed the installation of an 8" plastic natural gas main along Judas Rd. to Atwater Dr. for a new subdivision, 500 homes, located along Rankin Hill Rd. Gas is on the line.

Off of Highway 3, Kensington subdivision, second phase is ready. Running main in the final section. Back to work on inactive/retirements in Mooresville. Still working in Mill Village. Retiring main 150/115. Duke Power put a new pole w/in 6" of new line at 150/115 behind the mattress store. Still having issues on 77 with construction. Main renewal Hickory Street-very thankful to the Town of Mooresville.

Town of Mooresville-2 large sewer outfalls. One from Hwy 3 to Linwood Road down Faith Road to 115. Will open for development. Faith/115 at Lowes reworking the intersection.

City of Statesville-

DOT making progress at fourth Creek and Hwy 21 on bridgework. Building a temporary bridge to put in the new bridge. Buffalo Shoals Road-bridge work as well. Gregory Road is a dirt road, prepping it to pave. The rest area north of Statesville has opened. Unknown time frame for cut through at airport but they want to be aggressive to get the work completed.

West Iredell Water-

Business as usual.

Vermeer-Business as usual. Will be happy to retrain any folks who need trained on equipment.

NC Utilities Commission (Anna Williams) - spoke briefly about supporting pipeline operators and why they attend meetings.

Baxter (PSNC)=Call from the Town of Davidson-said they had a cut in the street that PSNC was responsible for-actually turned out to be AT&T (or contractors) who had done potholing and put dirt in the hole and patched with a "coal patch." The dirt had sunk in leaving a hole in the street.
