Chairman Ralph Murphy welcomed everyone and asked that they please sign in and silence their cell phones. He discussed a recent locate request with incorrect information. Please make sure you give the proper details when you submit a locate request.

NC 811 Education Liaison Howard Corey offered safety tips and briefly discussed preventing heat stress because June is National Safety Month. He also reviewed the totals from May and discussed upcoming events for July.

Looking at the numbers...

- **Jones County** total locate requests for May was **103**; **Onslow County** total locate requests for May was **1,882**.
- For **Jones County**, the majority of locates were requested in the **Maysville** and **Trenton** areas. For **Onslow County**, the majority of locates were requested in the **Jacksonville** and **Sneads Ferry** areas.
- There was a **2.5% increase** in locate ticket requests across the state for **May 2018**, compared to **May 2017**.

****LOCAL UTILITY UPDATES****

Piedmont Natural Gas – Scattered services throughout Jacksonville, working on Hwy 258 at Baker's Restaurant. Piney Green project probably won't get started this year as expected.

Jones County – A lot of fiber being installed. DOT is starting work on the culverts and cross tiles.

Onslow County Emergency Services - Fire Marshal Brian Kelly – Handling daily heat-related emergencies. Make sure to keep an eye on staff, hydrate, take breaks often. He also spoke about companies and agencies being prepared for hurricane season.

Ryan with Branz Safety – Wants to advise about new NC DOT work zone laws, effective July 1. Get with him if your staff needs training on that or if you need safety supplies as well. His email address if needed is ryan.zakany@branzsafety.com

JOEMC – Very Busy. Finishing up work at schools in Pender and Onslow counties. Working in 15 different subdivisions, many projects ongoing, wrapping up the LED change out program.

Safety Tips for working outdoors this summer



DRINK UP

Thirsty or not, drink plenty of water – a cup every 15 to 20 minutes. Avoid caffeine or alcohol which can dehydrate you.

ACCLIMATIZE

It takes time to adjust to working in heat. Work with your supervisor to gradually increase your work load and heat exposure.



Safety Tips for working outdoors this summer



COVER UP AND PROTECT

Wear light, loose-fitting clothing, UV rated sunglasses, and a wide-brim hat. Apply sunscreen with a Sun Protection Factor (SPF) of at least 30 and UVA / UVB protection. Re-apply every 2 hours and after sweating.

SHIELD FROM SUN

Set up shade structures or use umbrellas, buildings, or trees to shield you from the rays of the sun. You can get sunburn on a cloudy day.

TIME IT RIGHT

Try and avoid the sun and strenuous tasks between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. when the sun's rays are strongest.

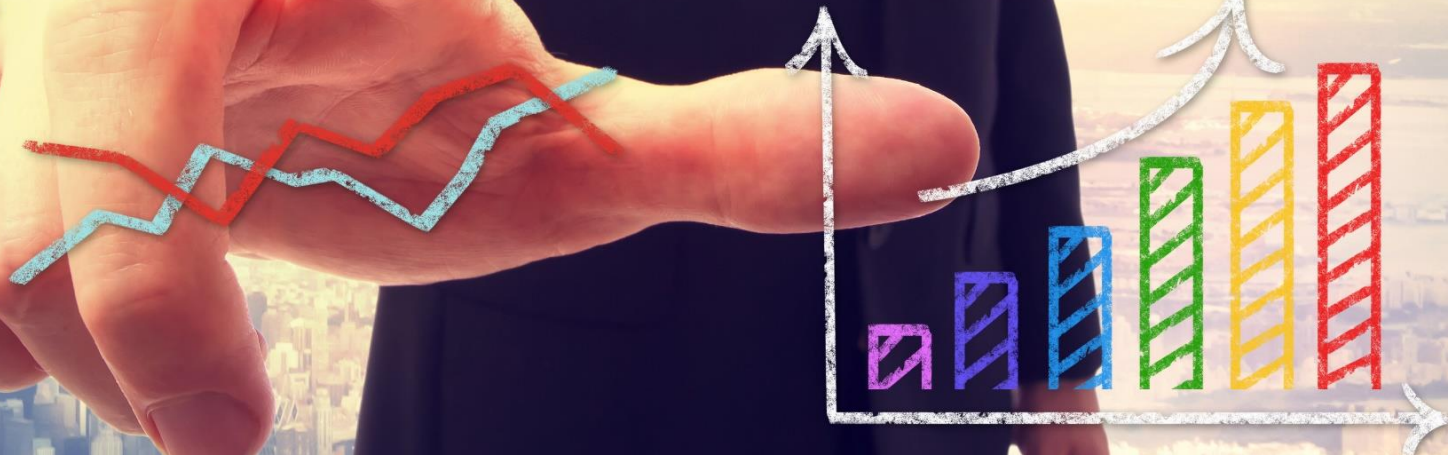
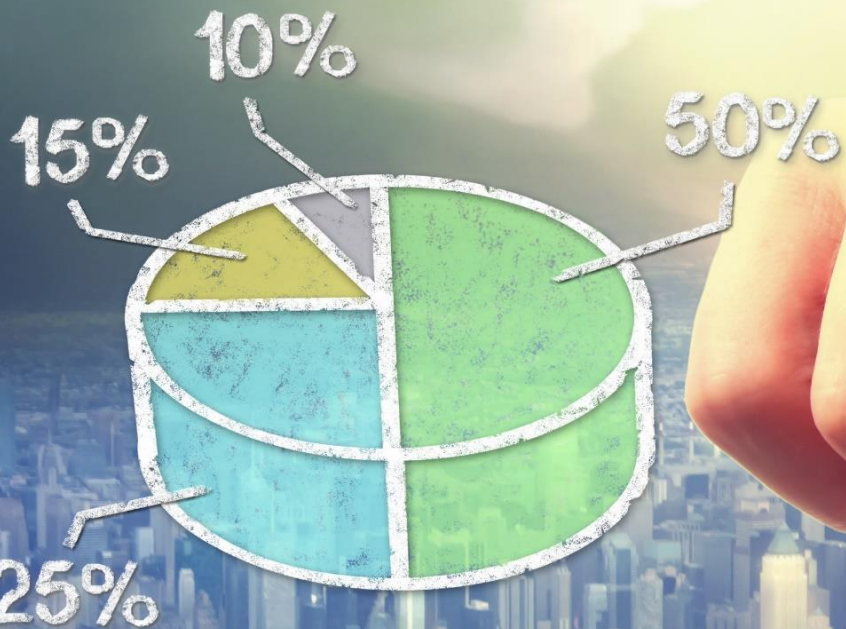
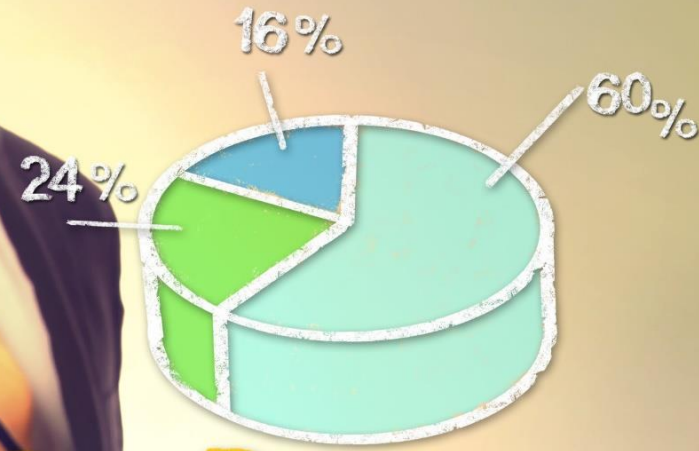
COOL OFF

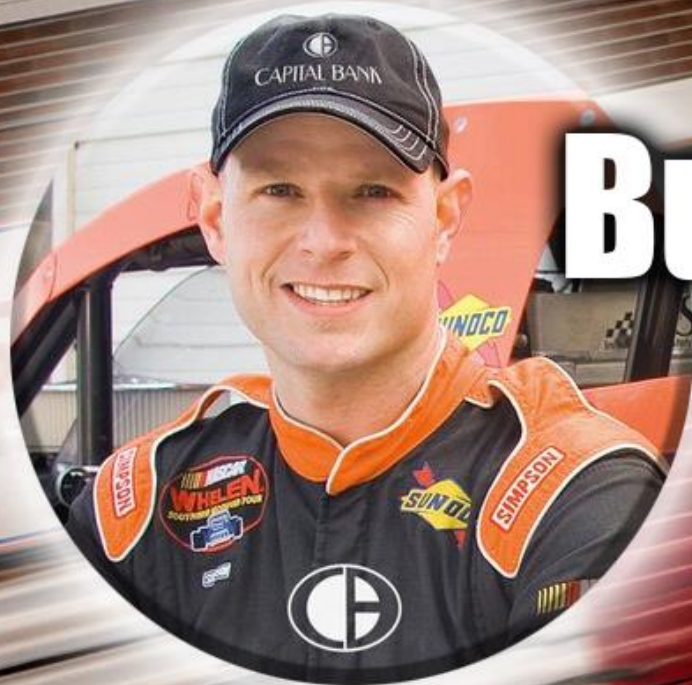
