- Hwy 401 to the Wake Co line is very busy with 5 miles of utility relocations going on.

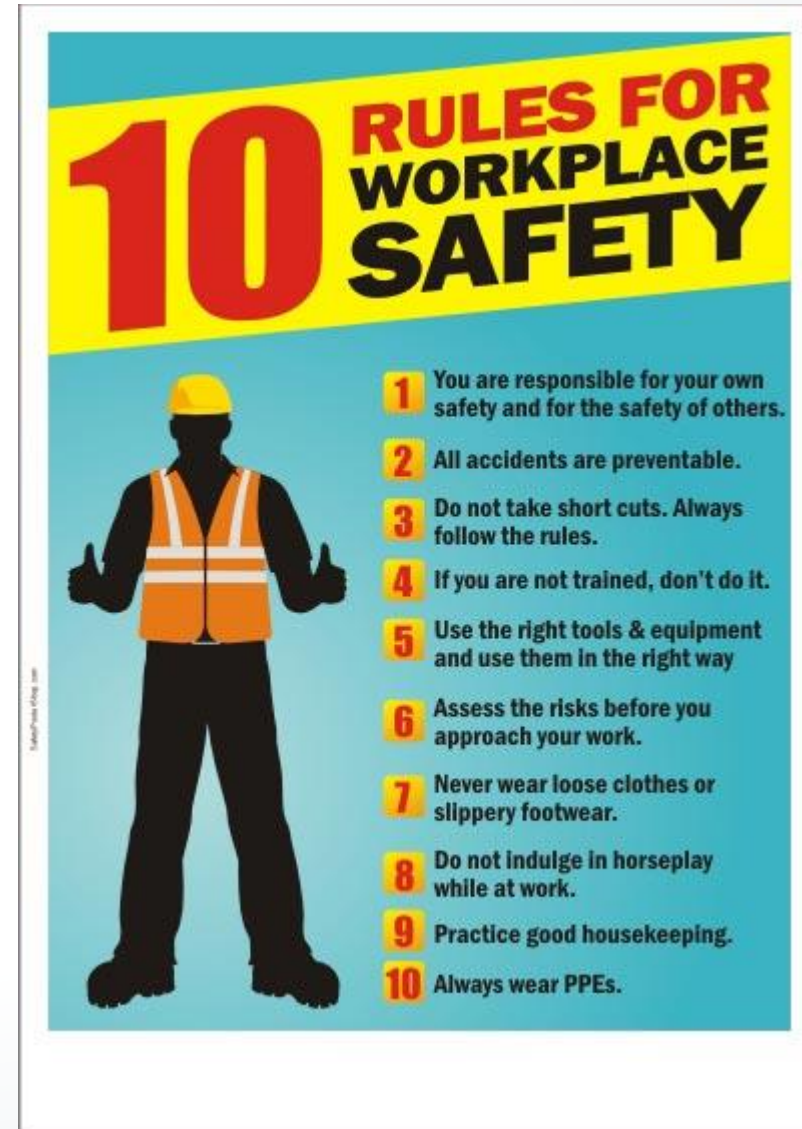
