- Safety moments: Be sure to check for limbs and other debris under vehicles and be mindful of leaving vehicles running while everything is so dry. It could cause a fire.
 - Stay off 85 in Warren Co if possible, there have been several wrecks due to construction. Try to stay on 158 Business instead. This is a 5 year project that started about a year ago.
- Level 3 fiber is being checked along US HWY 1
- Cape Hatteras locates are in house. A cable was miss marked and are looking at about a month for repair, so no power and no communication. Several law suits have been filed and more are expected.
- Hwy 401 to the Wake Co line is very busy with 5 miles of utility relocations going on.

New Business

- Safety moments: Make sure you do your 360 walk around, you never know when kids or animals could be around or under your truck
- New projects: PSNC Energy will be running about a mile and a half of pipe on Lawrence Rd and 8-10,000' of pipe in Ironwood. Duke Energy has completed Ironwood, Winston Ridge and Patterson Woods to be done. DOT – HWY 85 ongoing project.
- There are some contractors working without waiting for locates to be done. As long as positive response is cleared either before the 3 working days, or the 3 working days are up you should be able to begin work. If there are known contractors working before tickets are cleared please let Jeff Bartley know and he will be glad to give them a courtesy call.
 - Same contractor has caused damage in the same subdivision twice. Not working safe.
- Build relationships to co-exist and work together.
