- Safety Moment: Someone was doing work on a busy road, miles of traffic, had employees in a 5' hole at the edge of pavement with arms out and laying on the edge of the hole with no traffic control. They were in a hurry and did not go through DOT as they should have. The fastest way is not always the safest way. Please take time to contact DOT to ensure you have your proper encroachments and traffic control. When digging, if 5' hole will need to be 5' off road, if 10' hole need to be 10' off pavement, etc, per DOT.






