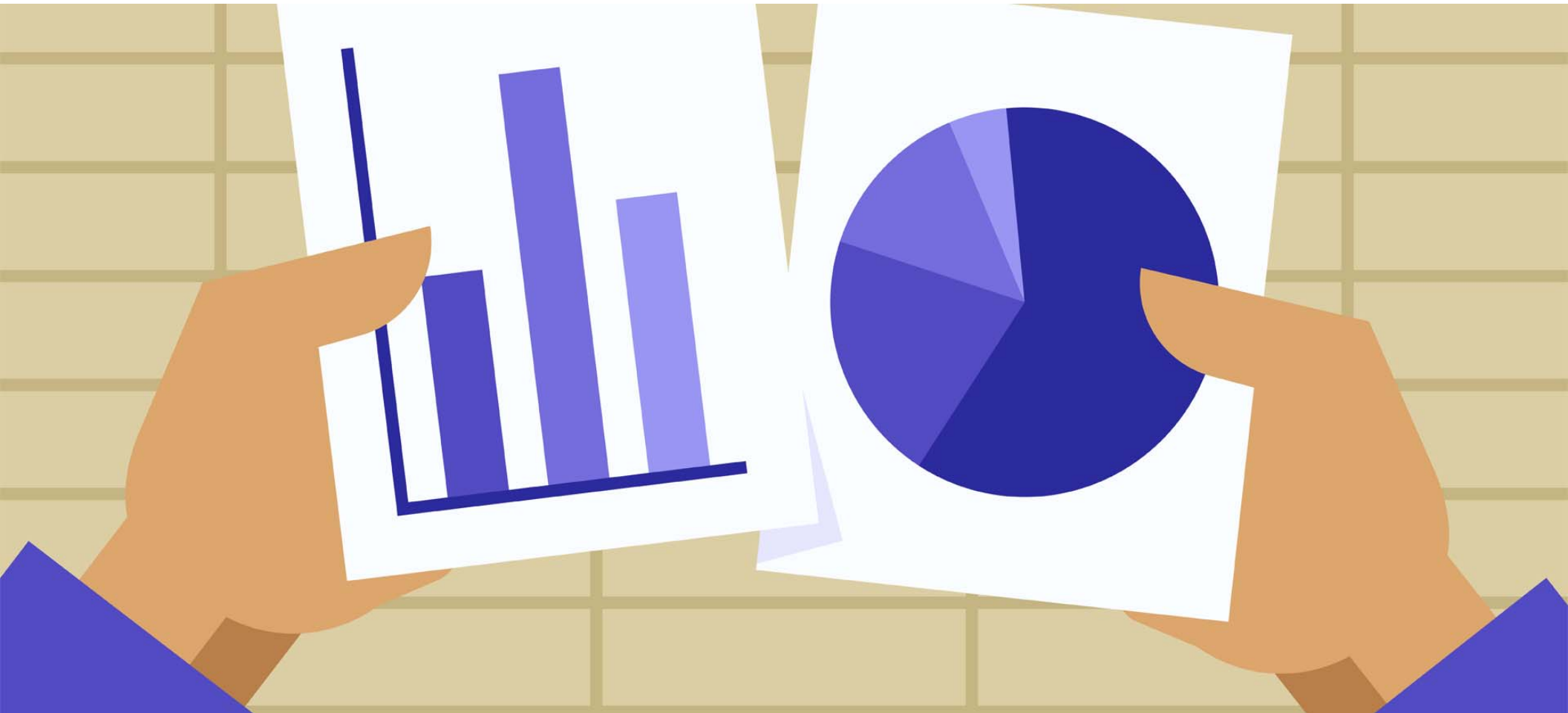

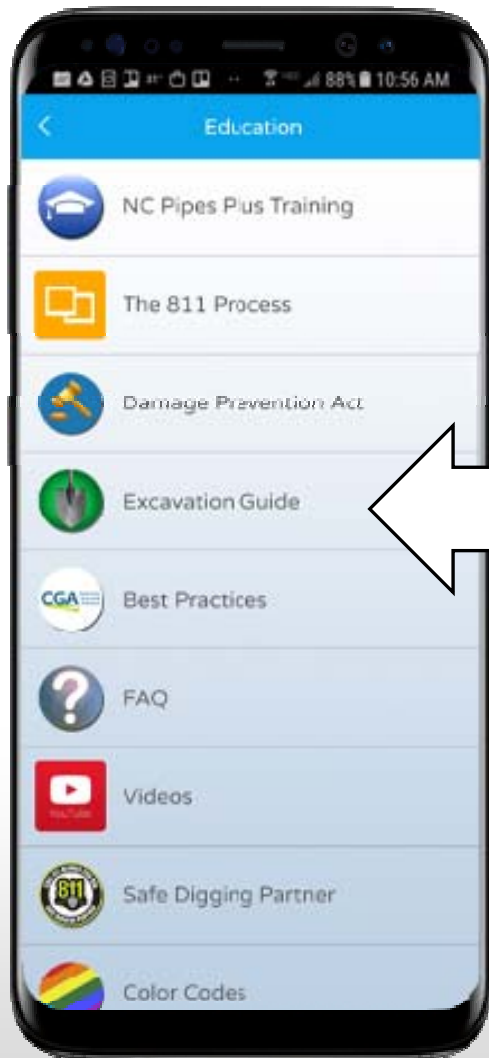

Meeting Time: The meeting was called to order by Michael Lamping at 8:30 a.m.

Total Members Present: There were Sixteen members.

Recent Damages: There were no significant damages that this group were aware, within Lee County, since our last meeting.

New Business and Projects:

Lee Paris with NCDOT, stated: Highway 42 and Broadway street, continuing to widen this road and install new sidewalks. Resurfacing project near Deep River Road and also bridge replacement along this project. Michael Lamping, with city of Sanford, stated that a couple different companies are renovating the Kmart, which had been closed. There will be a workout – fitness center, two new restaurants and an Ollies store that will occupy this building.

NC811 Presentation:

Kevin Smith gave the NC811 presentation and gave considerable time on the importance of contractors not updating a ticket until the twelfth day, having the locate request accurate in the description of the address, if white lining, do not include, locate entire property, and not to call in locates for area's which will not be worked immediately upon locates. Kevin also reviewed the NC811 app and went over key features of this app. He stressed the importance of having the "App" as one of the most important tools all utility personnel could have.

Kevin also asked contractors / companies not to request locate tickets for which the actual work will take place immediately. Several companies call / request locate tickets for projects that are months down the road.

General Discussion:

Group discussed on ways to continue inviting new members to this group. Kevin, stated he will try to increase the attendance with some additional emails and telephone calls.
