

Survey design ticket – these are used for designing projects. A facility has 10 working days to respond to this ticket instead of the usual 3 days.

White Lining – Best Practice Statement states when the excavation site cannot be clearly and adequately identified on the locate ticket, the excavator designates the route and/or area to be excavated using white premarking prior to the arrival of the locator.

Rule of thumb is to mark 25 feet past the white line area

### **Meeting Topics**

1. Any locate issues we can help each other with:
  - Support the white lining. The City of Wilmington has incorporated the white lining in their permitting
2. Are there any safety issues or concerns we need to discuss about our utilities:
  - Irrigation / Landscaping are trenching back of curb without a City of Wilmington permit.
  - River Lights subdivision has Power primary, secondary, street lights and Communications all in the same ditch with direct burial
3. Anything new as far as the way you install, repair or maintain your utility:
  - Piedmont Natural Gas now has their tracer wire under the pipeline
  - 4 inch coil pipe with line tamer was used for Piedmont Natural Gas on their project. Picture of the pipe and tamer was passed around the room
  - Power has been known to put more lines in the same trench but only use one mark for locating. They have a contract issue that is being looked into. They want to move to putting one mark for each line so there are not confusions of how many lines there are underground
4. Any new / large projects starting up or updates on existing projects:
  - Brunswick Forest is looking at putting in 400 lots by the end of this year
  - BCPUA and PNG have Hwy 211 project in Southport coming this summer/fall
  - City of Wilmington – Multi-use path from Holly Tree Dr to S. 17<sup>th</sup> St and Multi-use path along Park Ave from Empie Park to Audubon Blvd to Kerr Ave

BCPUA asked Piedmont Natural Gas for a liaison meeting to discuss gas pressures and how to work around natural gas. Joyce to get with Cory with contact info.

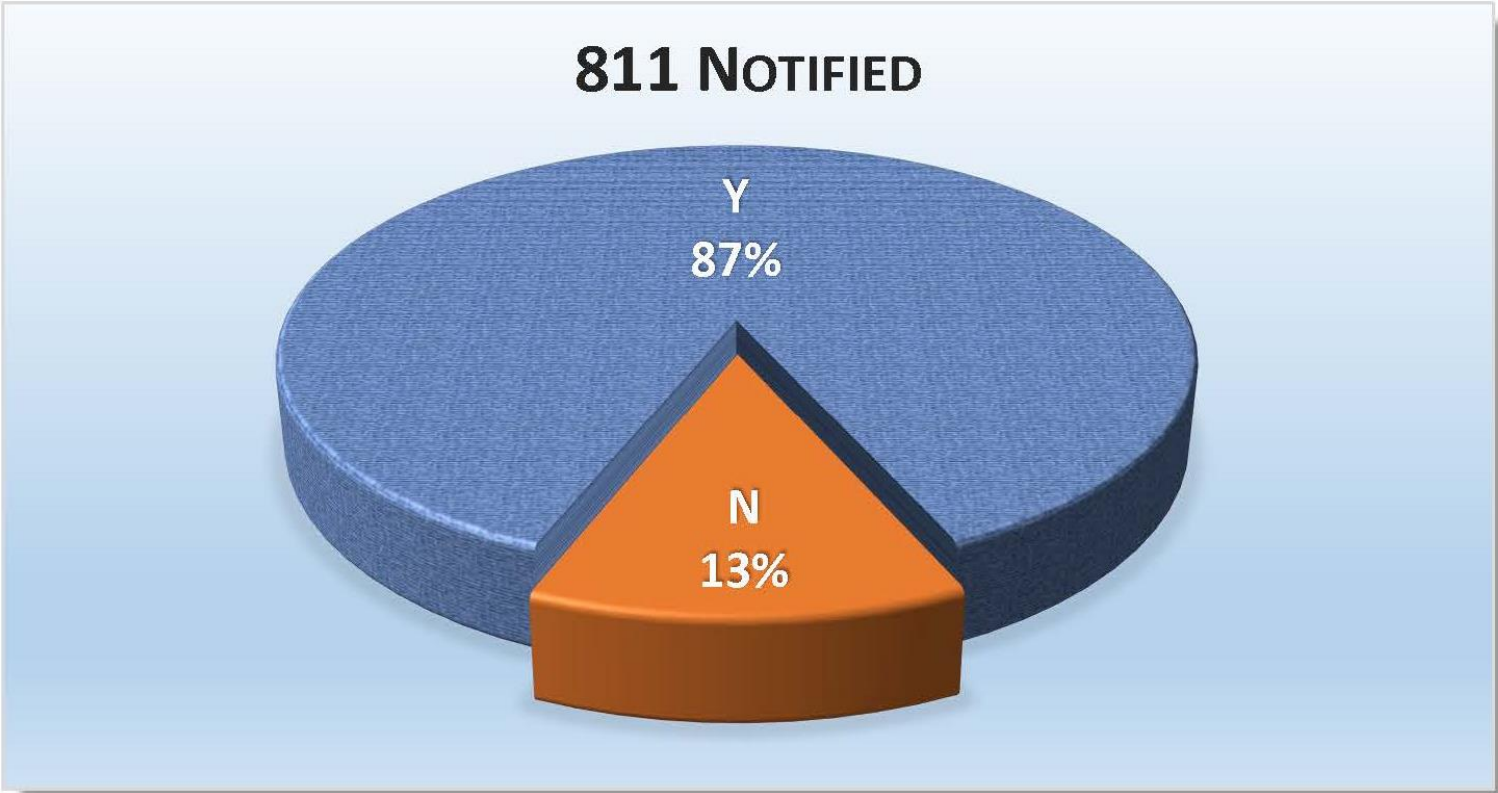

# WHITE PAINT OR FLAGS ON A JOB SITE ELIMINATES GUESSWORK.

Sometimes it is difficult for excavators to relay the exact location of their dig sites to the one call center. Even clear and accurate information relayed in writing or verbally to one person may not be clear to another. With white lining, locators have excavation information on paper, and also have a clearly marked excavation area. White lining helps to avoid misinterpretation and allows for more accurate locates.
